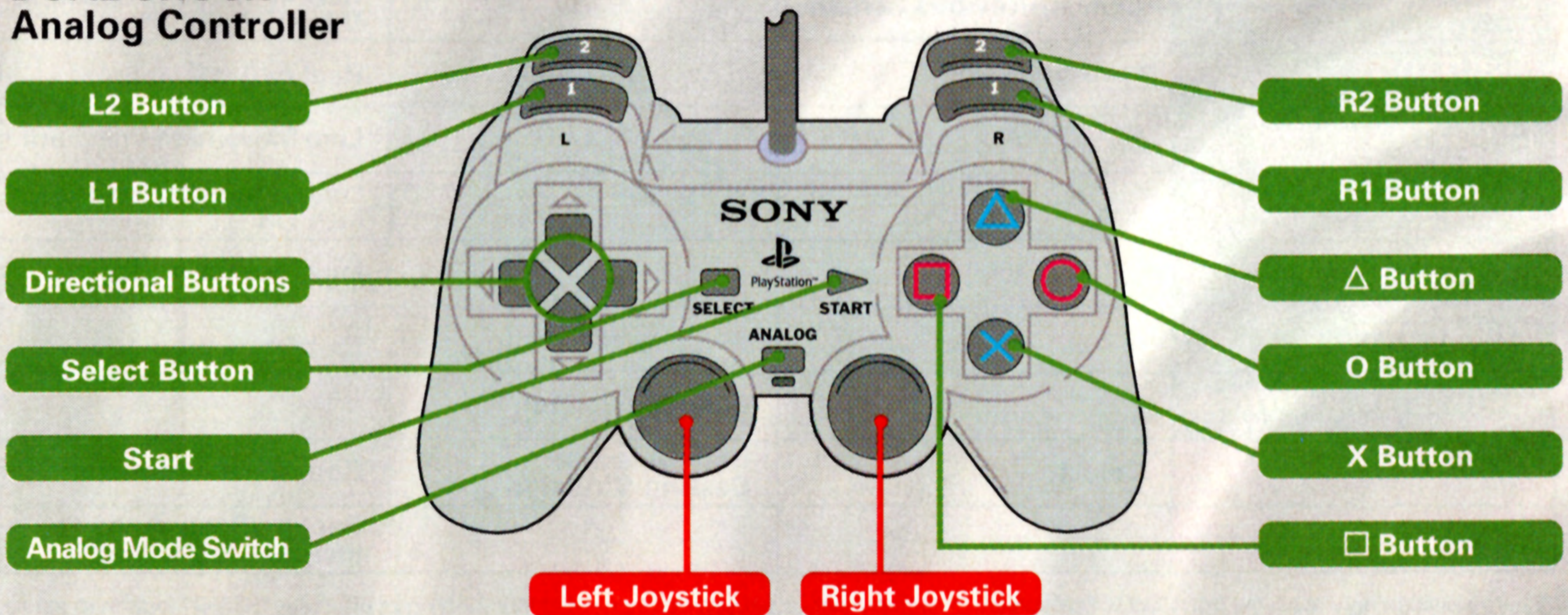
# USING THE CONTROLLER

The following instructions illustrate how to use the controller with Bass Rise™. When you catch a fish, the controller will vibrate in both analog and digital mode. **Note:** When using an analog controller, press the "Analog Mode Switch" on the controller before pressing "Start."

\*Lure selection only available from Tackle Box screen. \*\*Game must be paused before turning vibration on or off. Press "START" button to pause.

# GETTING STARTED

Press "START" button for title screen. Using directional buttons, select desired mode. Press "START" to begin game.



## Single Play

Use this mode to fish in various locations. Using directional buttons, select "NEW" to begin a new game, or "LOAD" to continue previous game. Then press "START."

If you select "LOAD," screen will prompt you to select Memory Card slot 1 or 2. When game loading is complete, press X Button.

## Vs. Play

Use this mode for 2 or more players. Players should alternate using the Player 1 controller.



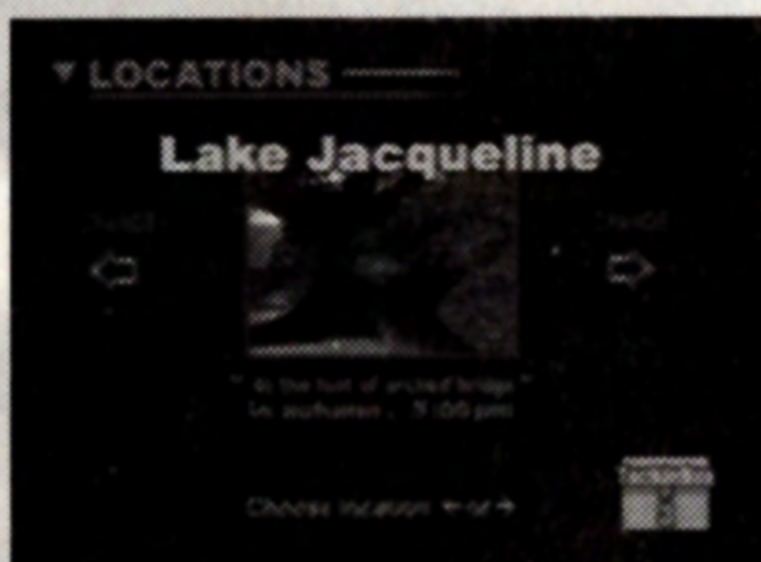
## Option

Select "OPTION" to change any of the following:

- BGM volume (background music)
- Sound effect volume
- Sound output (stereo or mono)
- Information display
- Status display (line tension and length)
- Navigation display (help on/off)
- Controller settings
- Exit

# SINGLE PLAY

**Single Play** – Use this mode for 1 player. Choose from the following MENU selections.



## Go fishing

Select fishing location. (For detailed fishing instruction, see HOW TO PLAY section.)



## Lures

Use this screen to select or change lures in your tackle box. You can use up to three tackle boxes. Each tackle box holds up to 12 lures.



## Records

Check your current record for each level. Display standings according to: TYPE of fish (Large Mouth Bass, Small Mouth Bass, Blue Gill); LINE (8 lbs., 12 lbs., 16 lbs.); or SIZE (length, weight).



## Save/Load

Save results from current round or load results from a previous round. Only one round can be saved on each memory card. To save a round, return to Save/Load option in MENU.

## Back to title

Go back to title screen.



## **Vs. Play**

Begin the match after setting the rules in the "Rule Setting" screen. Controller usage is the same as for single play.

## **Number of Players**

2 to 4 players can compete.

## **Game Method**

Choose from 1-5 rounds, 1-5 casts per round.

## **Three Types of Competition**

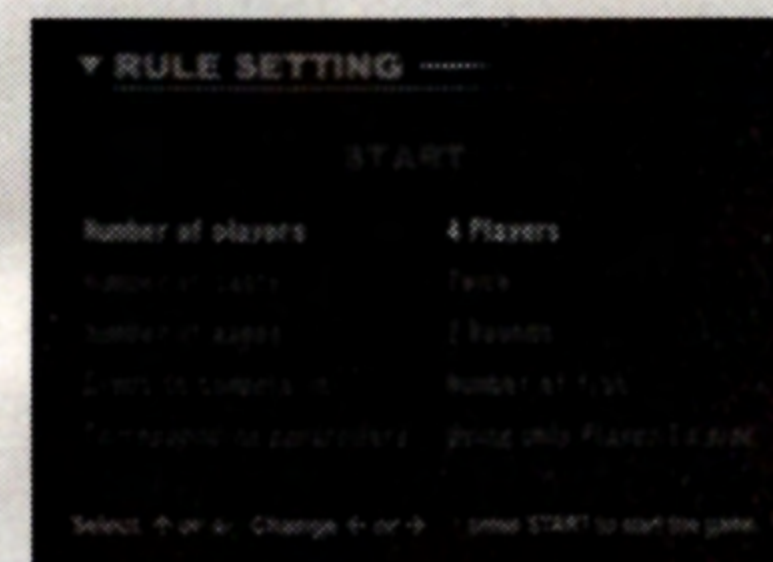
Compete according to weight, length, or quantity (except Blue Gills).

## **Game Style**

Use 1-Player Port only. Players alternate using one controller. If a second controller is plugged in, both controllers can be used.

## **Rules**

Each player casts the same number of times per round and earns points depending upon ranking. The player who earns the highest points after all rounds are completed is the winner.



## VS. PLAY

### To calculate total points –

1. Figure total for each player per round.  
Weight match – combined weight of all fish.  
Length match – combined length of all fish.  
Quantity match – total quantity of fish.
2. Award points by ranking.  
For 4 player match, 4 points are awarded to the first place player, 3 points for second place, etc. For 3 or 2 player match, first place gets 3 or 2 points, respectively, and so on down the ranking. Players who tie are awarded equal points.
3. Award bonus points.  
See chart below.

RECORD BONUS	For player who sets a new weight record: 1 point (Record remains after game)	For player who sets a new length record: 1 point (Record remains after game)	
DEFENDING BONUS	For player who maintains the weight record: 1 point (After each round)	For player who maintains the length record: 1 point (After each round)

# HOW TO PLAY



## CHANGE TACKLE

### Lure

All lures in tackle box will appear on the screen. Use ▲ and ▼ directional buttons to select a lure. Press X button to execute.

### Line

Use ◀ and ▶ directional buttons to select a line weight. Press X button to execute.

## CASTING

Use ◀ and ▶ directional buttons to change casting direction.

Use □ + ◀ or ▶ directional buttons to change player view.

Press X button to cast.

## FISHING

Press ○, △, and/or □ to reel in lure and maintain tension. Press L1 button to attract fish by moving lure.

When you have a fish lined up with your hook, press the L2 button to hook the fish.

Press ○, △, and/or □ to reel in fish.

**Note:** To ease line tension and prevent line break, you can slow/stop reeling or press the ◀ and ▶ directional buttons in the same direction that the fish is swimming. When navigation display function is set to ON, arrows will indicate the best direction in which to move the lure.
