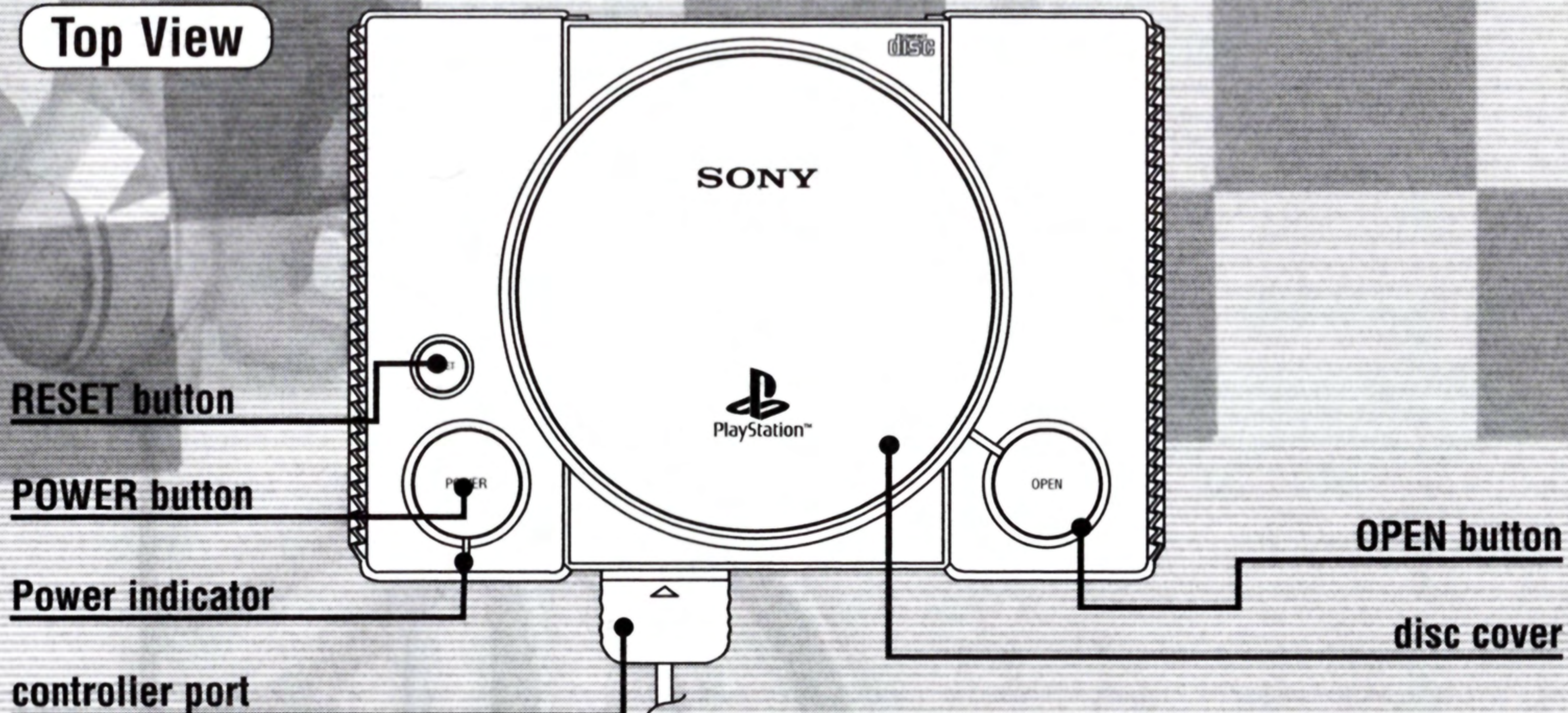

CONSOLE INSTRUCTIONS

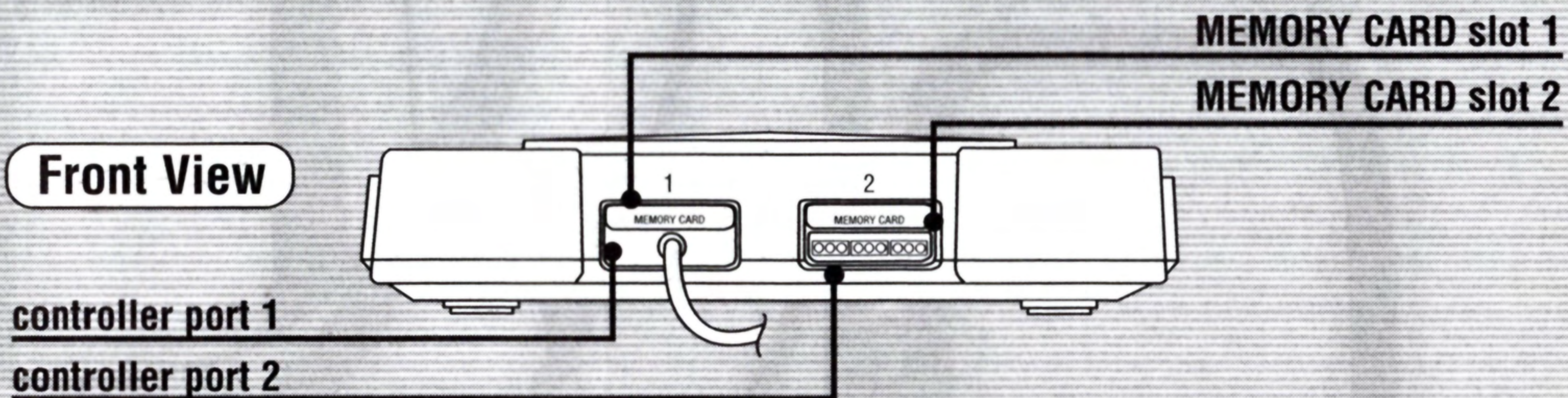

Top View

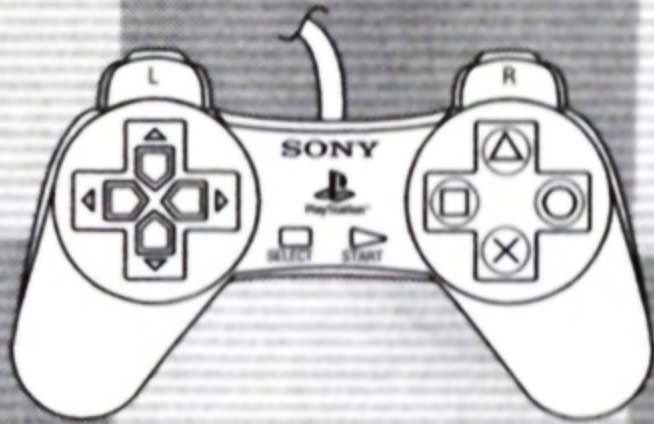

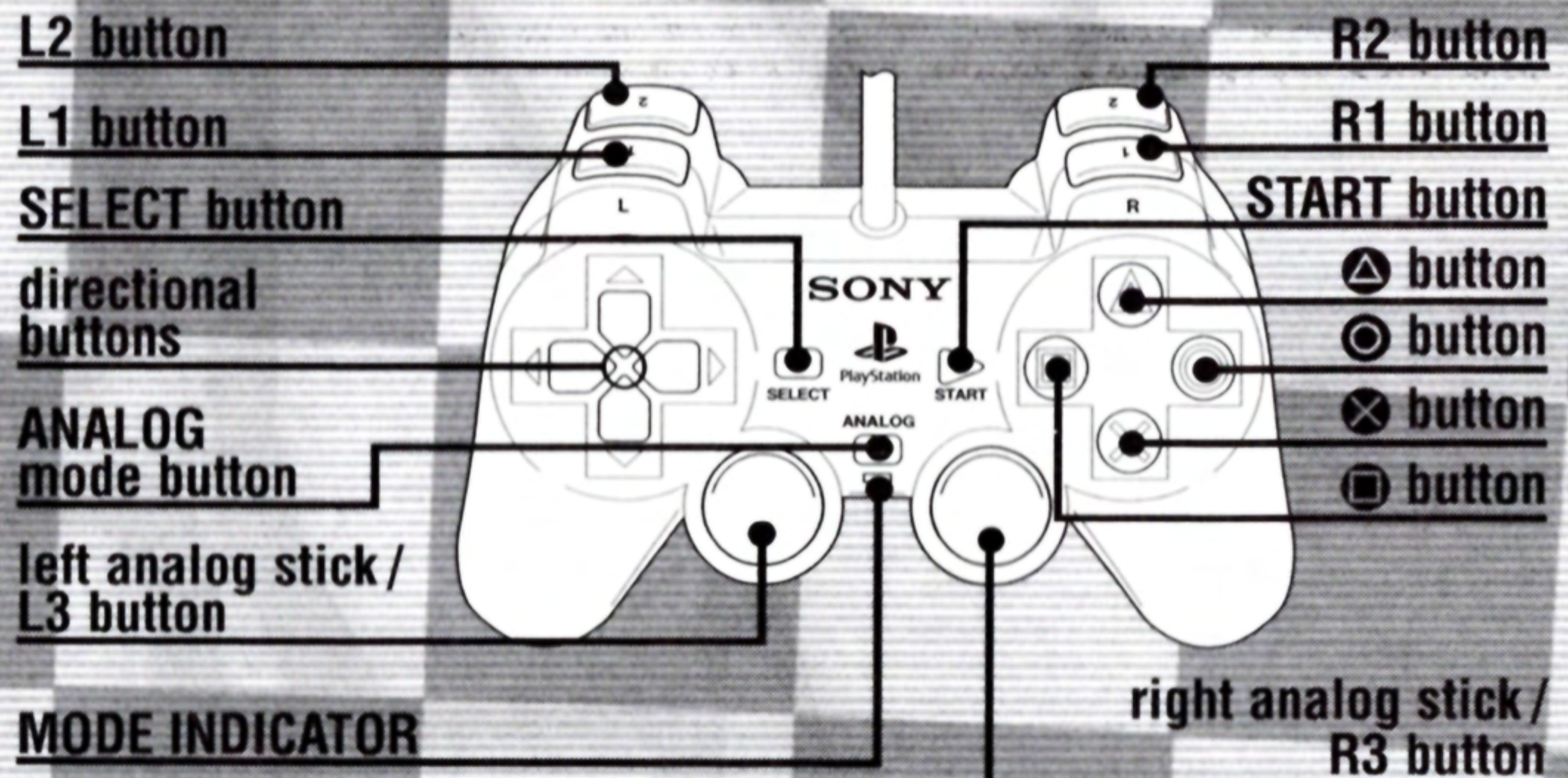

MODE SELECT



Select screen. Use the directional buttons to highlight menu selections and either the  or  button to confirm a selection.

Mode Select

Grand Prix:

Race against CPU controlled opponents. Place in the top three to participate in the next race.

VS:

Two player versus mode.

Time Attack:

Race against the clock.

Memory Card:

Access this option to save and load game data.

Options:

View course records and adjust various game settings.

RACE SCREEN



Position:

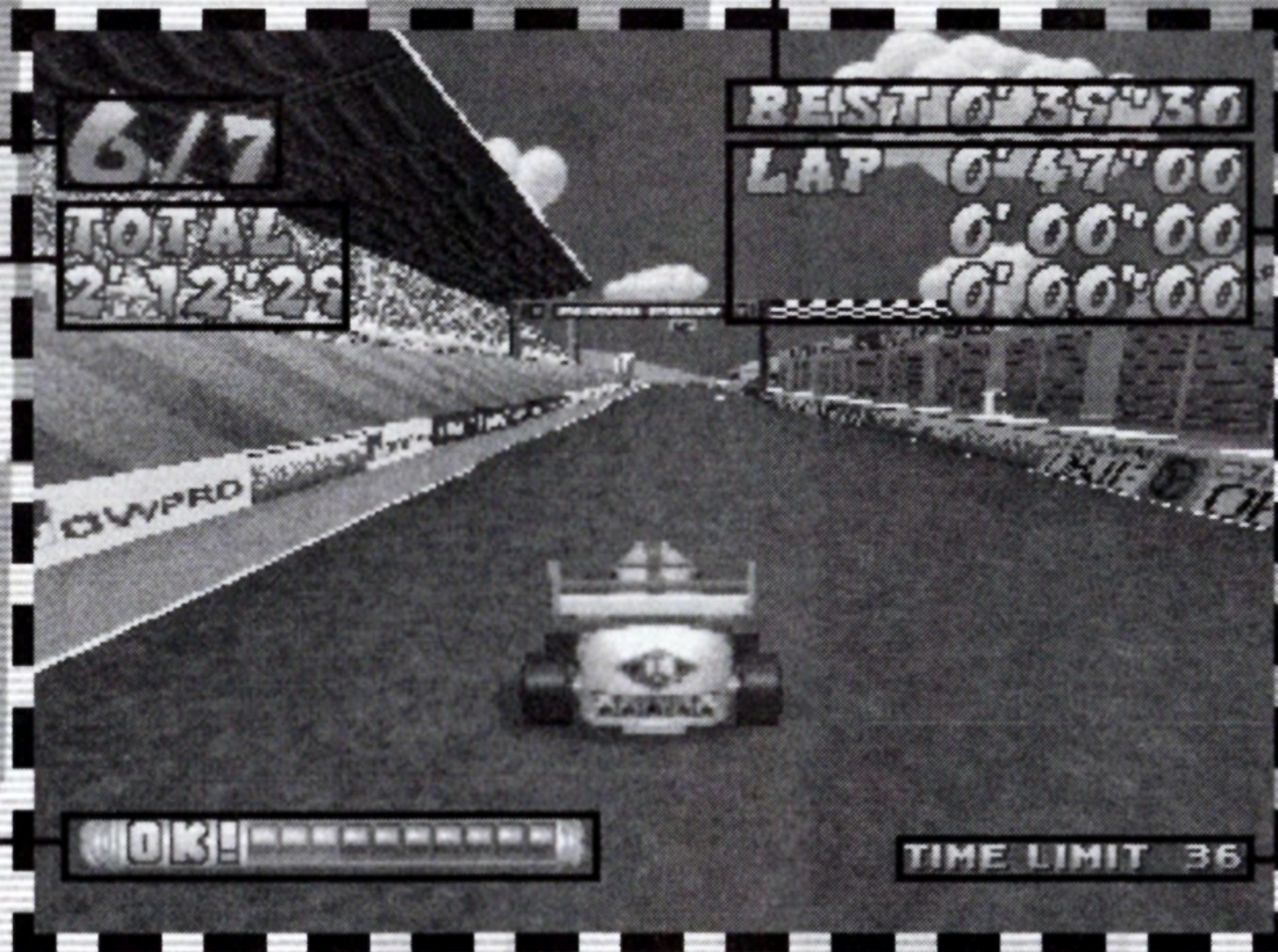
Displays current race position.

Total:

Displays the best overall course time.

Turbo:

Pick up turbo capsules to fill the turbo gauge.



Best:

Displays best lap time.

Lap:

Displays lap times for laps 1-3.

Time Limit:

Indicates the time within which a lap must be completed. If the counter reaches "0", the race ends. Pass checkpoints to gain additional time.

RACE MODES



The driver select screen is displayed after choosing a race mode.

Use the directional buttons to highlight the desired driver and either the **○** or **⊗** button to confirm selection. Some of the game's twelve drivers must be unlocked before they can be used.

Vehicle specs are displayed once a driver has been selected.



Driver/vehicle selection can be confirmed at this point by selecting YES, or cancelled by selecting NO.

Vehicle Specs

- Speed:** Vehicle's speed
- Acceleration:** Vehicle's acceleration
- Control:** Vehicle's control/handling
- Weight:** Vehicle's weight



Course selections are made after confirming driver/vehicle options.

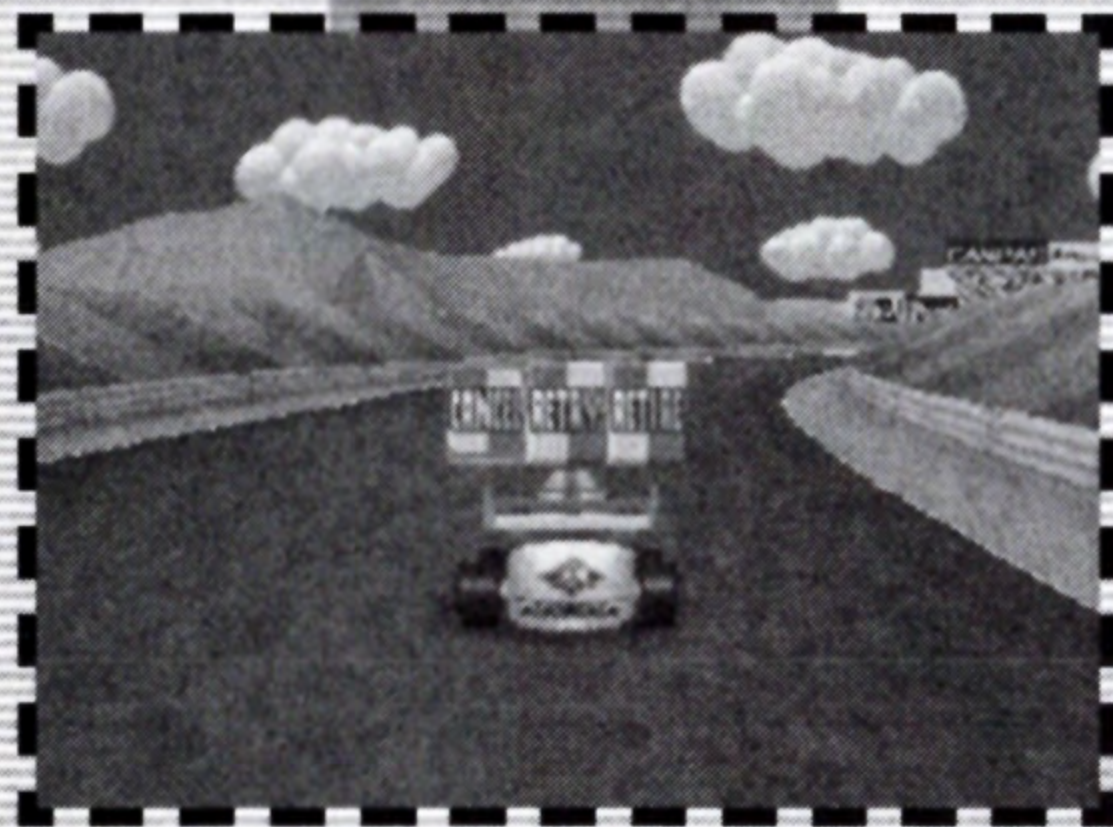

The following options are available on both the race result and pause game screens: Retry, Change Driver, Change Course, and Retire.



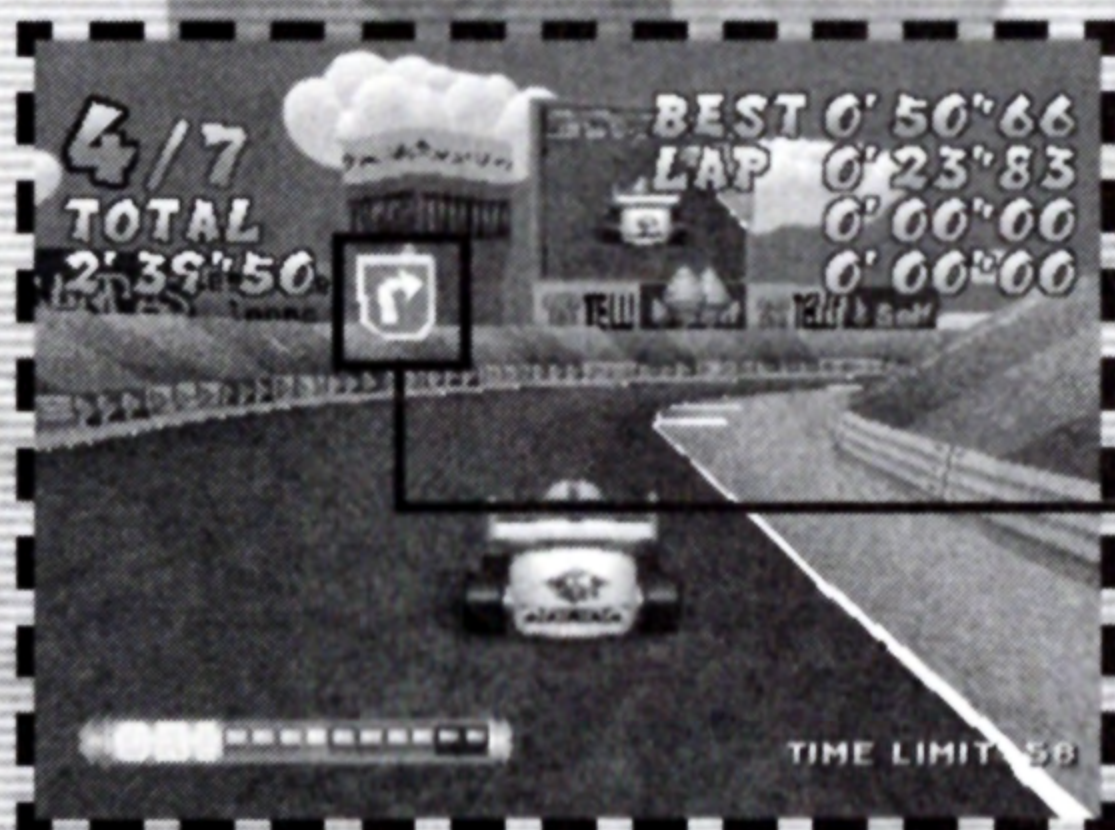
Retry: Play again on the same course

Retire: Return to the Mode Select screen



Turbo

Turbo Capsules

Fill the turbo gauge by picking up turbo capsules that appear on the course. The gauge can be filled to a maximum of ten bars. Different colored turbo capsules fill a different number of turbo gauge bars. Engage the turbo feature while on a straightaway to improve your race position, or secure the lead.



Drift

Utilize drifting techniques to take turns as quickly as possible and ensure a fast lap time.

Impending Turn

Performing a drift maneuver -- As the vehicle approaches a turn, steer into the turn and press the button on the controller that corresponds to the drift function.

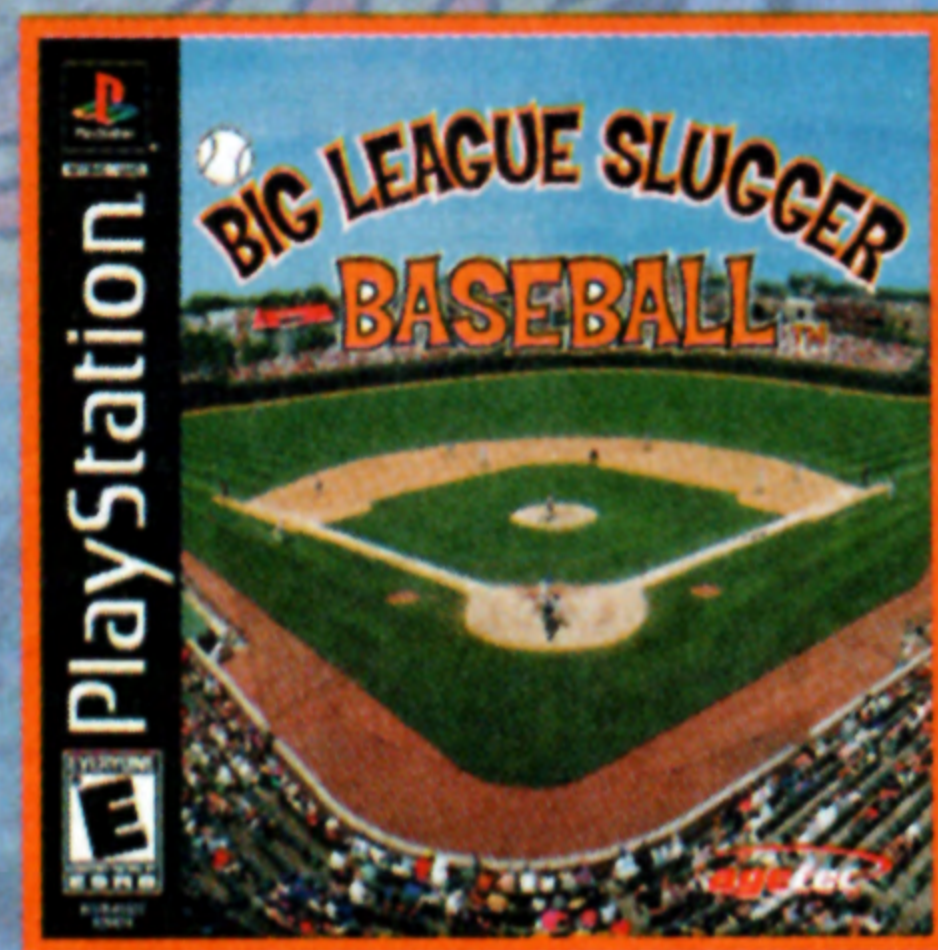
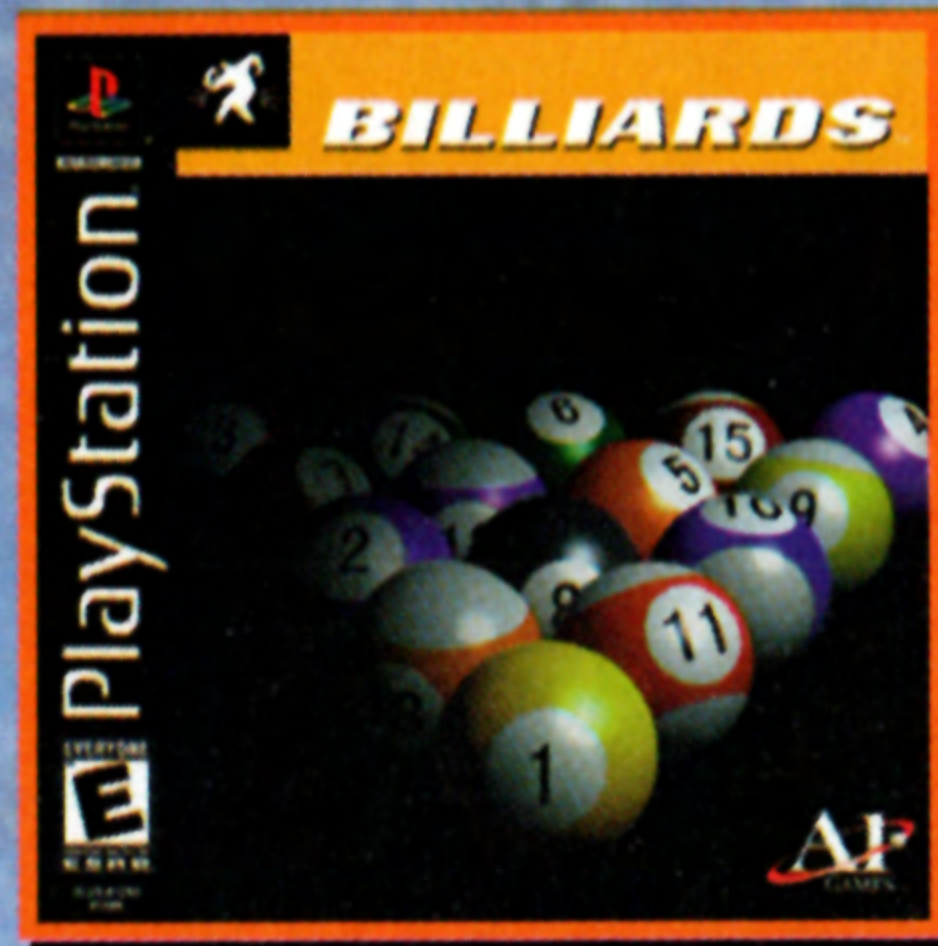
