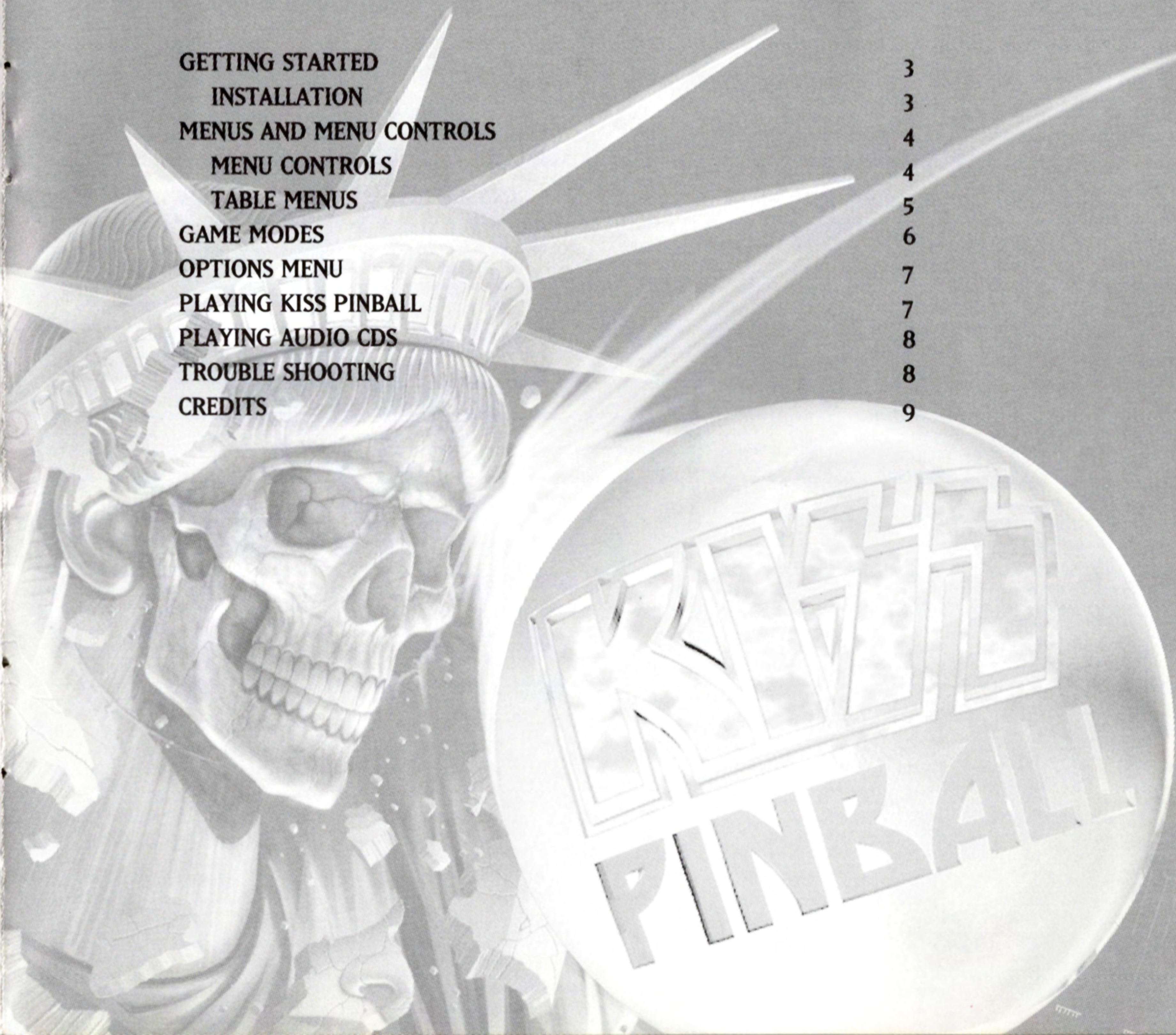

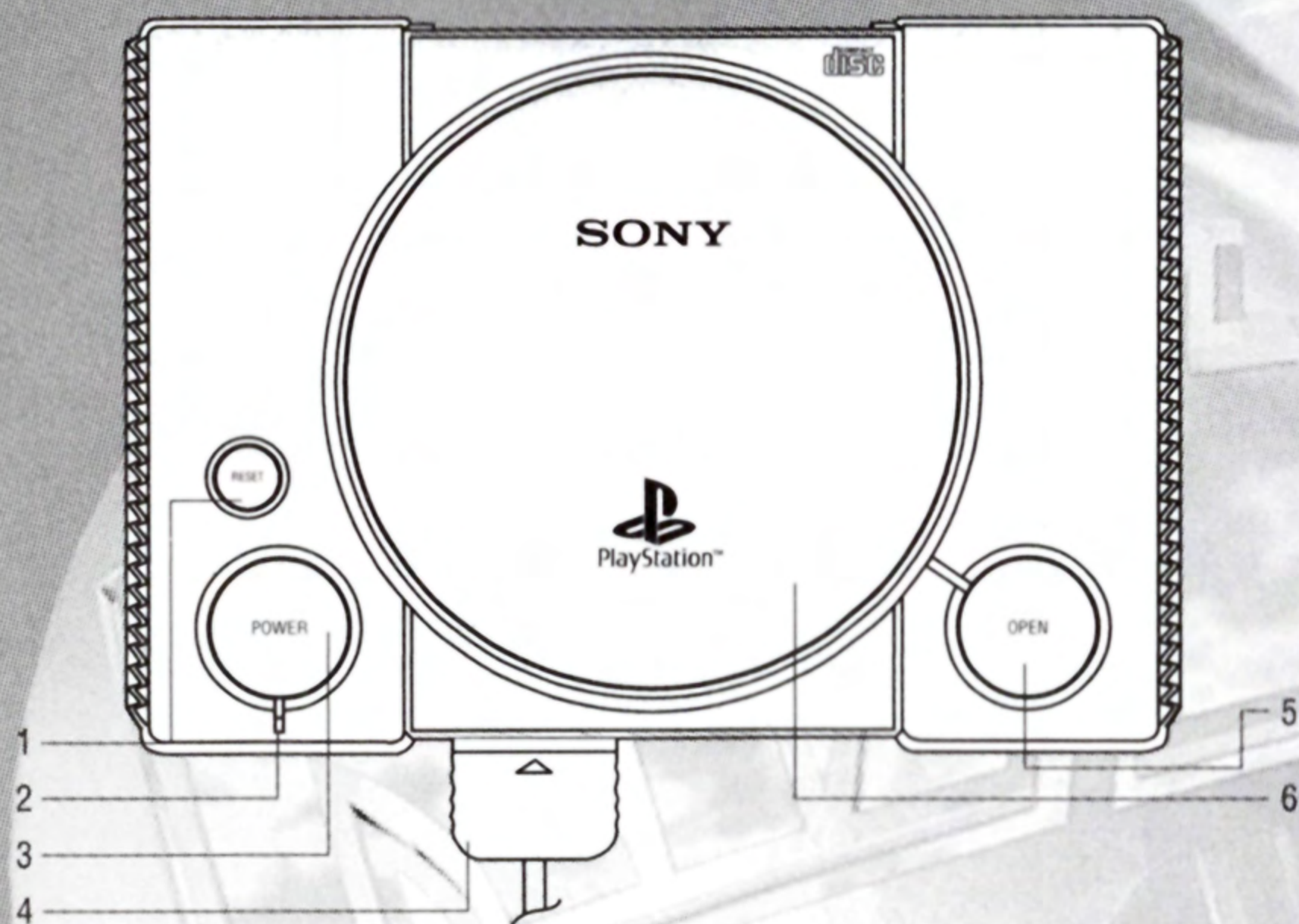
GETTING STARTED

Installation

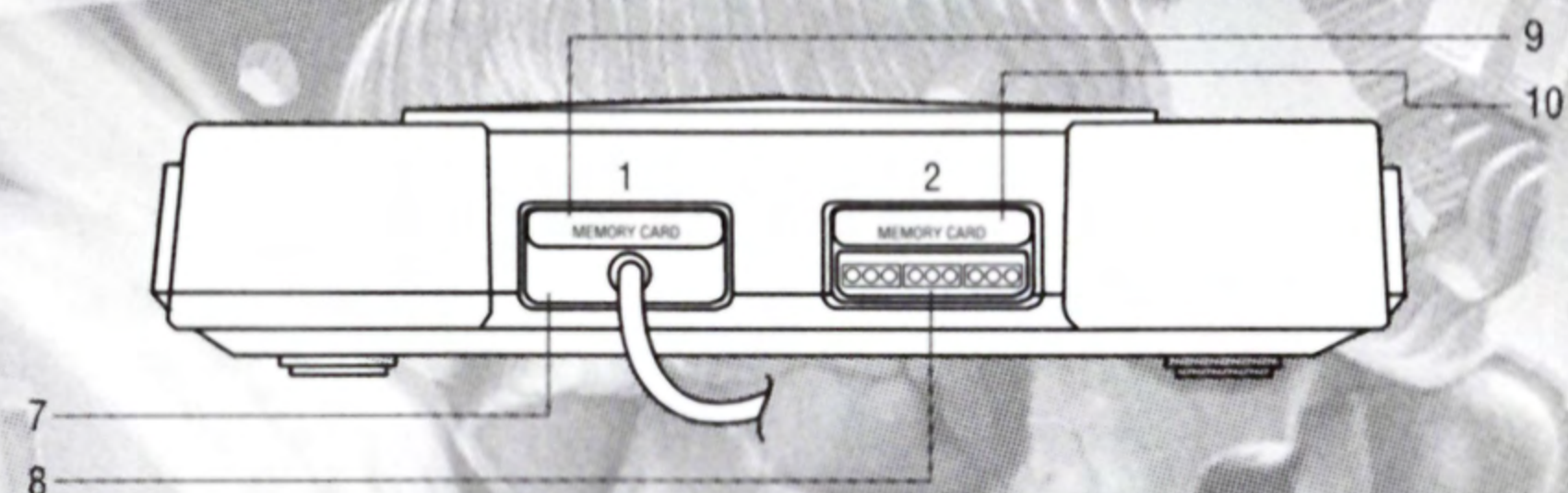
Set up your PlayStation® game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the power is off before inserting or removing a compact disc. Insert the KISS Pinball disc and close the disc cover. Insert a Controller and turn on the PlayStation® game console. Follow the on-screen instructions to start the game.

If you wish to save your game you will need to have a MEMORY CARD inserted in MEMORY CARD slot 1 or MEMORY CARD slot 2 with at least 1 block of free space. KISS Pinball requires 1 block of free space to save. It is advised that you do not insert or remove the MEMORY CARD once the power is turned on. Removing the MEMORY CARD during saving or loading may cause saved data to be damaged or lost.

Top view

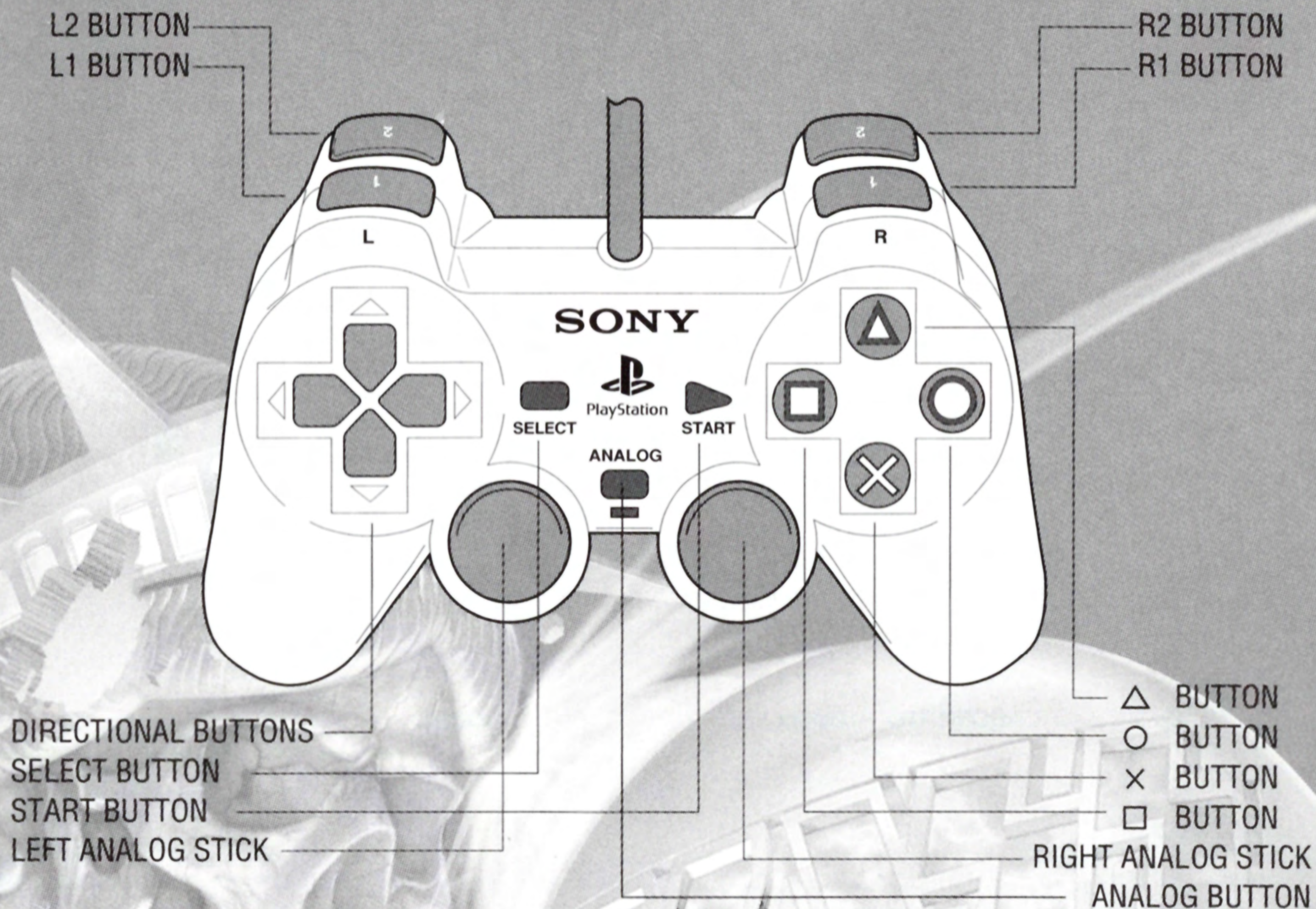


Front view

MENUS AND MENU CONTROLS

Once the title screen appears, Press START button to continue.

MENU CONTROLS

× button accepts a highlighted option.

△ button rejects an option and takes you back to the previous menu.

Directional buttons (←→↑↓) navigate the menu screens and highlight options.

Choose from one of two tables – **"Last Stop Oblivion"** or **"Netherworld"** by highlighting the table's graphic and pressing the X button.



Select backstage to enter the game options screens.

TABLE MENUS

There are two tables to choose from each with four game modes.

"Last Stop Oblivion"

KISS are back in town and they're really rockin'. Join the party by getting past security for a hard won autograph. Jump in the KISS jet for a world tour. Upgrade your transport with shots to the Ace scoop. Shoot huge scores and watch those record sales go sky high.

"Netherworld"

It's all for rock and rock for all as the band members battle the Dark lord and claim the kissneth as their own. Collect lost souls and lock balls with Gene's tongue! Journey into the pit and rescue your own groupies from the clutches of evil – if you dare!

Select a Table from the main menu to display the game modes and information.

GAME MODES

- **Novice:** The same as Regular play except that the ball saver is active for several minutes.
- **Regular:** Standard 5-ball play with extra balls, end-of-game score matching, and Powerball bonus mode.
- **Arcade:** 3-ball play with Extra Ball awards based on score. There is no end-of-game match.
- **Tournament:** Random game play elements have been standardized, and there is no match or Powerball and points are awarded instead of extra balls. This is to make Tournament games as directly comparable with each other as possible.

Highlight the mode button you wish to play with the directional buttons and press the X button to start.

Highlight "Scores" beneath each mode and press the X button each time to see the current High Scores for that mode. If you get a High Score you will be prompted to enter your name at the end of the game.

Use the directional buttons to enter your High Score in the dotpanel. Press the X button once you have finished.

Once a game mode has been selected it will load in its attract mode and display basic instructions in the dotpanel. To play a one-player game press the X button and then the X button again to fire the ball. To add extra players to the game (maximum of four) during the table's attract mode use the directional buttons and then the X button to confirm your choice.



PINBALL

Options Menu

Accessed by selecting "Backstage" from the main menu.

- Music Volume: Adjust music volume using left and right directional buttons.
- SFX Volume: Adjust volume of sound and voice effects using the left and right (←→) directional buttons.
- High Scores: Load, Save or clear High Scores.
- Back: Back to select table by using the X button.

PLAYING KISS PINBALL

- X button: The default key for pulling back the plunger to fire the ball.
- L1 button and R1 button: Default keys for the flippers (L and R).
- ↑ Directional button: Default key for Nudge UP.
- ← Directional button: Default key for Nudge LEFT.
- → Directional button: Default key for Nudge RIGHT.
- L2 button: Play previous audio CD track.
- R2 button: Move forward to next audio CD track.
- Note: Too much nudging will tilt the table and void the current ball.
- START button: Pauses and unpauses the game. It also provides a status report on jackpot levels, ramp counts, extra balls, etc. in the dotpanel window. While the game is paused, use the directional buttons (↑ ↓ ← →) to view the table. Press △ to quit the game and press △ to quit the tables.
- High Scores
Enter Name:
 - 1) Use up/down directional buttons (↑ ↓) to select a letter.
 - 2) Use right/left directional buttons (← →) to move forward or go to the previous letter.
 - 3) Press the X button to confirm.

PLAYING AUDIO CDs

As a real bonus players have the option of playing their very own KISS (or any group of their choice) audio CDs while playing KISS Pinball. To use this fantastic feature simply pause the game while playing (this can be done before launching the ball), open the disc cover, and follow the instructions that appear in the dot panel. You will still hear the normal sound effects during the game, and the sound volume is still controlled via the Backstage Game Options Menu. Use the L2 and R2 buttons to move backwards and forwards through the tracks on the CD.

Warning: Please do not remove/swap the Kiss PSX CD before entering gameplay.

To revert to the normal in-game music or to change an audio CD simply pause the game and open the disc cover.

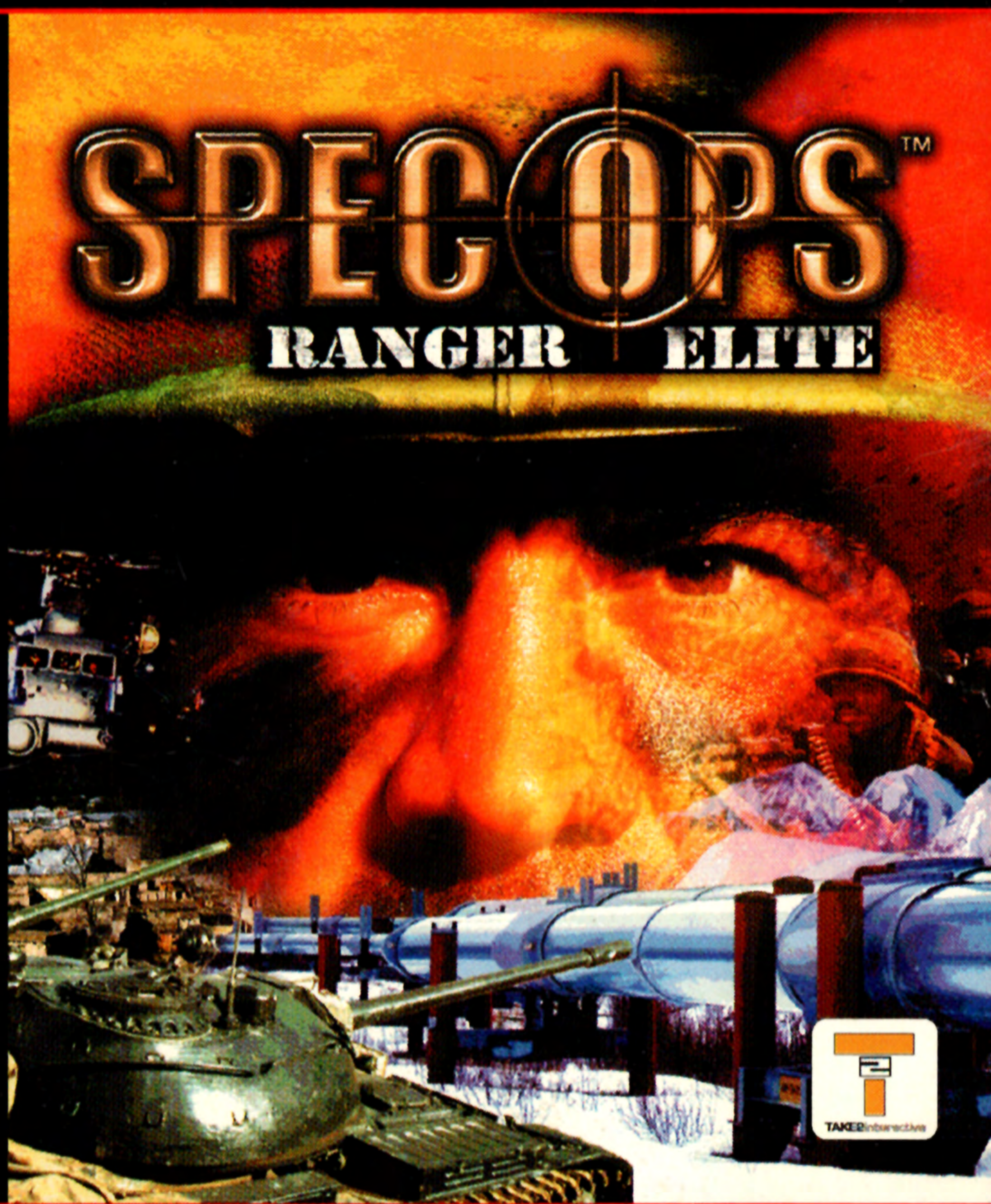
