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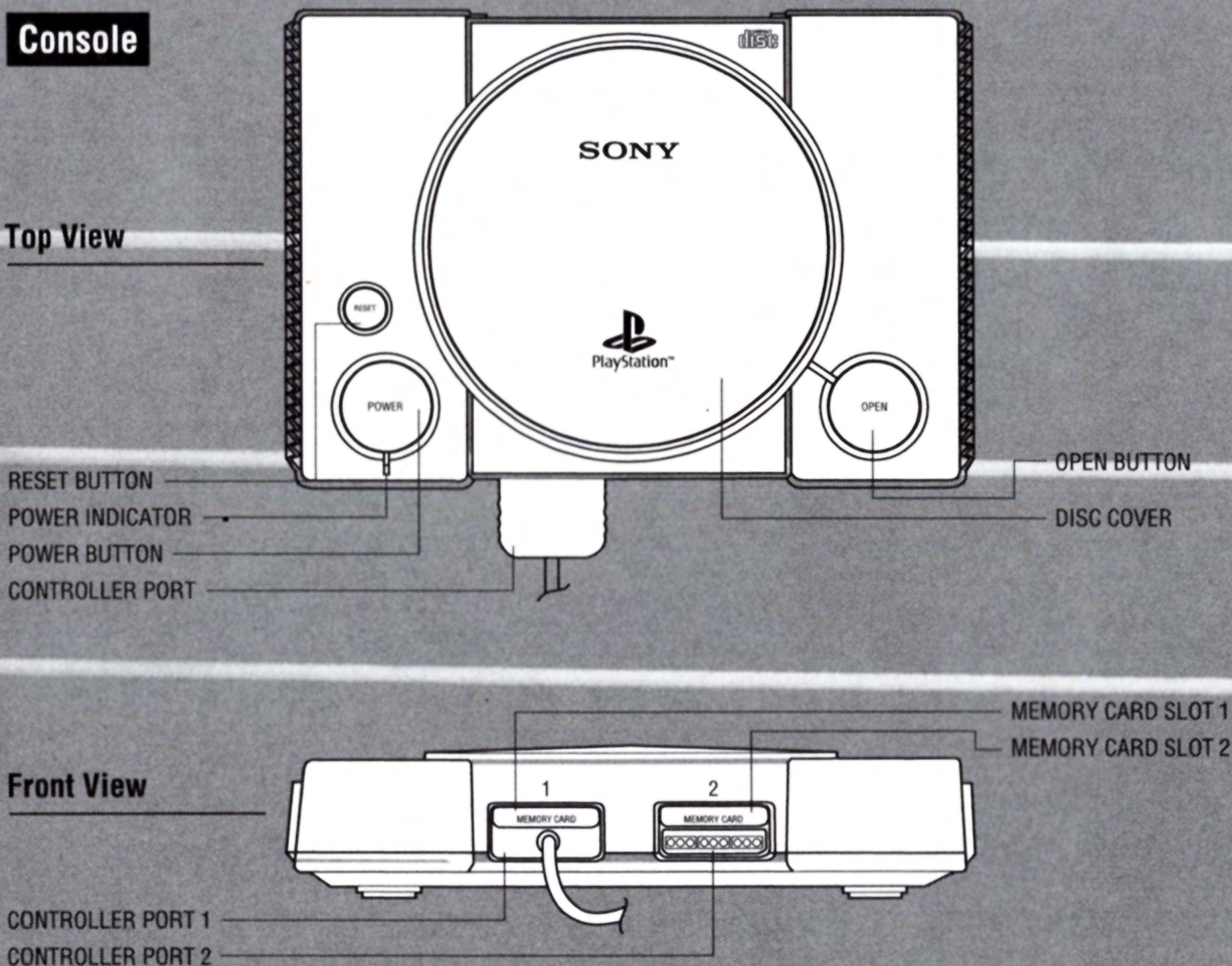
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GETTING STARTED

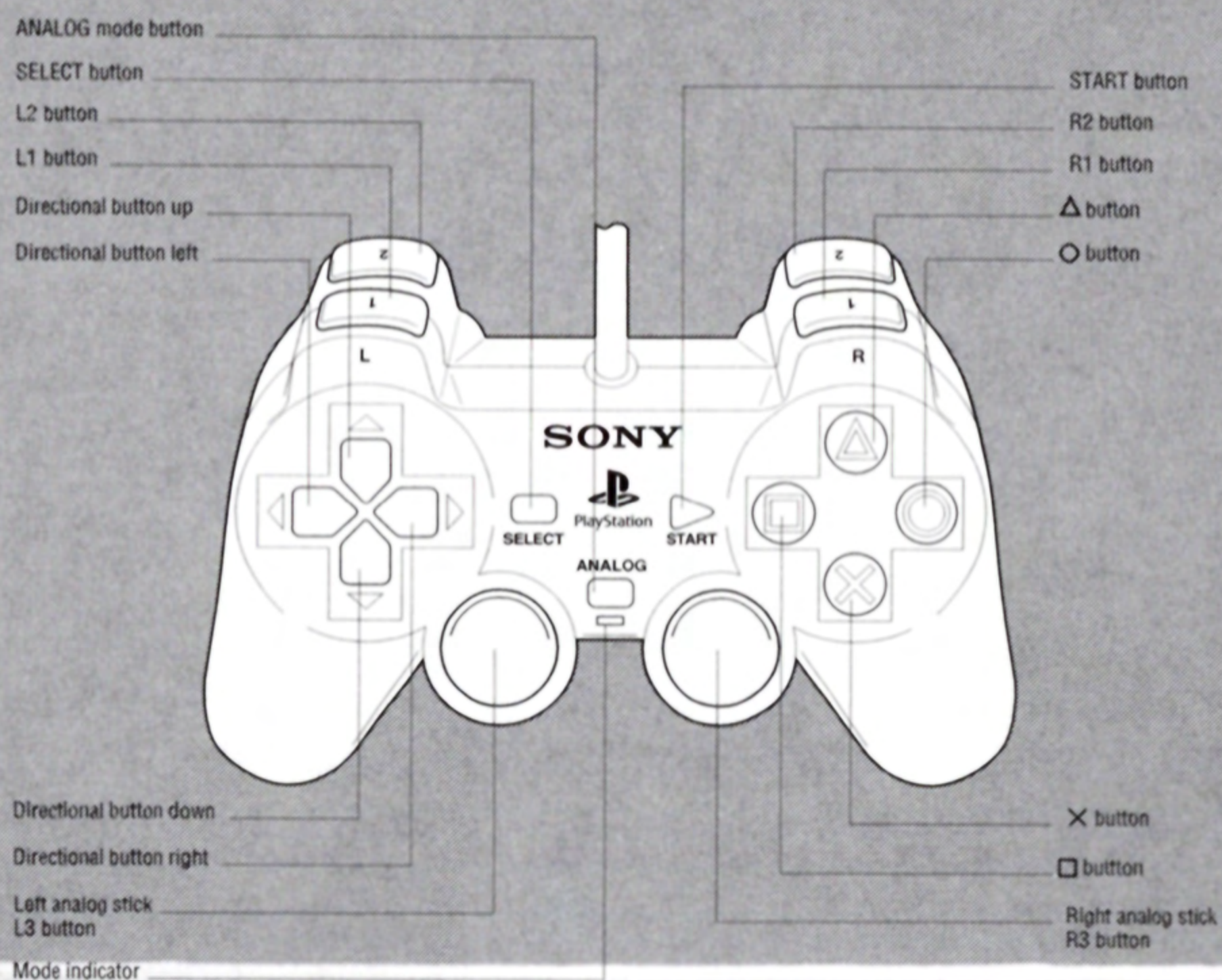
Set up the PlayStation game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the Power is off before inserting or removing a disk. Insert the Celebrity Deathmatch disc and close the Disc Cover. Insert game Controller and turn on the PlayStation game console. Follow the on-screen instructions to start game.

If you wish to save your game you will need a MEMORY CARD (Celebrity Deathmatch only supports MEMORY CARD slot 1). It is advised that you do not insert or remove peripherals or MEMORY CARDS once the power is on. Make sure there are enough free blocks on your MEMORY CARD before commencing play.

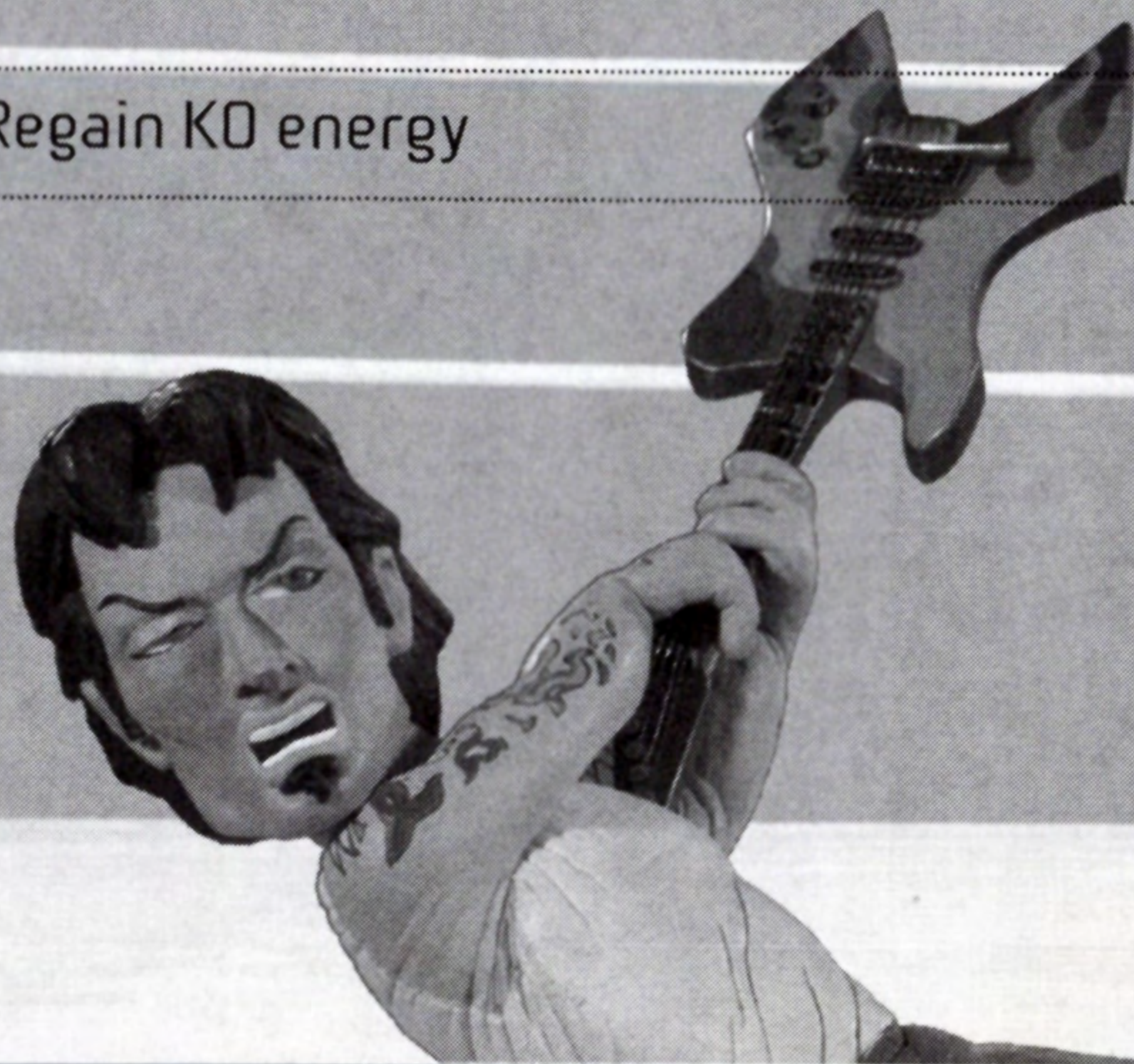

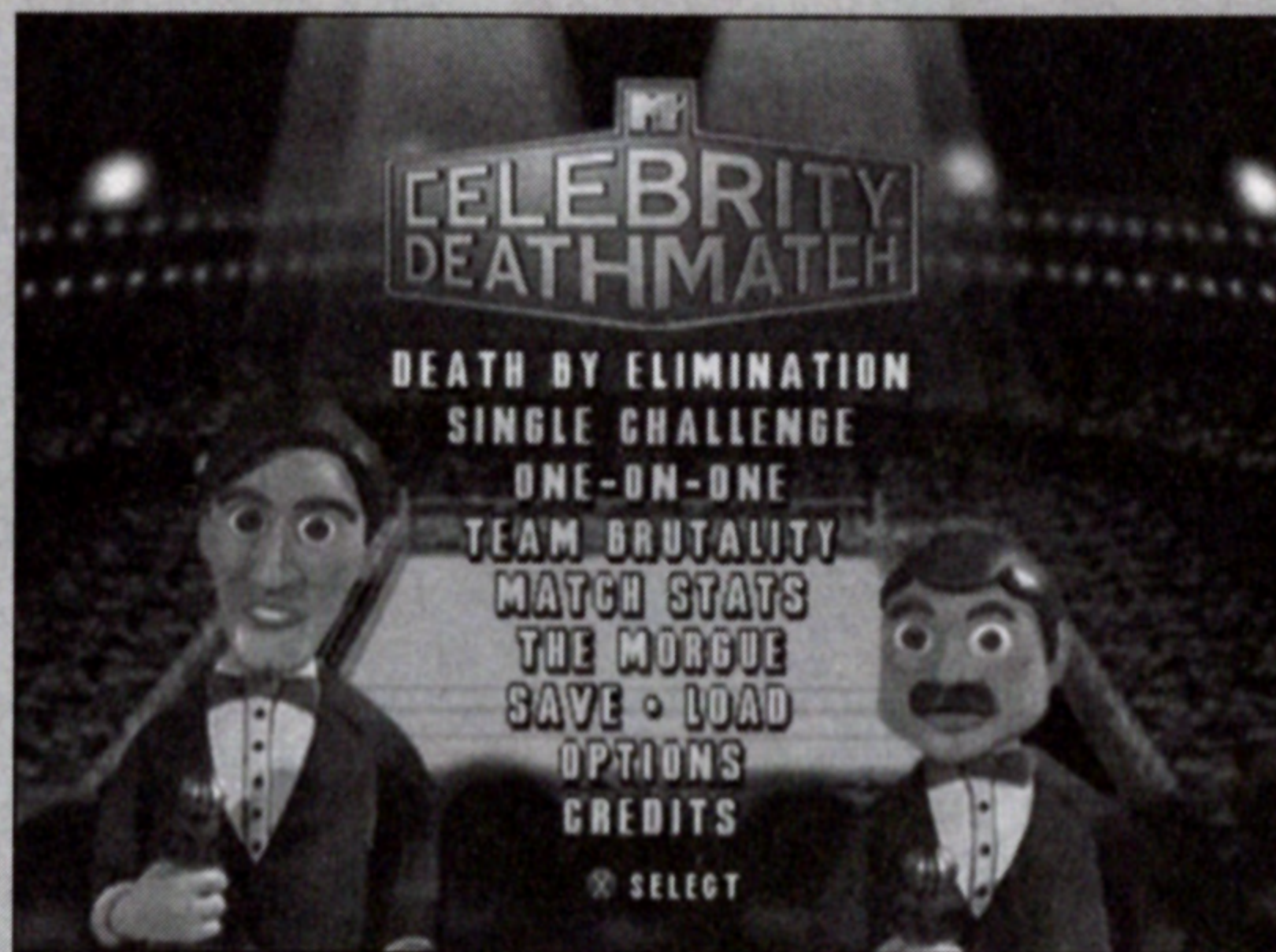

MAIN MENU



Death by Elimination

This mode allows you to play against the AI in a one-on-one match up. Simply pick your celebrity from the 8 available in the Player 1 window and get ready to fight to the death. By eliminating opponents, you will unlock hidden celebrities (a total of 3), which you can use throughout each mode. When selecting a celebrity, make sure to check out the Stamina and Strength meters to better match a celebrity to your personal fighting style. Each opponent, ring style and match time limit is randomly picked in this mode.

Single Player

This mode allows you to play against the AI in a match up where you pick your opponent, ring style and match time limit.

One-On-One

This is the classic Multiplayer mode of player-vs-player, and can only be entered by having a controller in Slot 2 of your console. Both players must select a celebrity and ring style in this mode.

Team Brutality

This Multiplayer mode allows you to select 3 celebrities per team, and can only be entered by having a controller in Slot 2 of your console. Player 1 will select a 3 celebrity team and a ring style; Player 2 will select a 3 celebrity team and the match time limit.

Match Stats

This feature allows you to view the number of wins, losses and/or draws of all celebrities for both single player and multiplayer modes. If you do not save your game, all data here will be lost.

The Morgue

This keeps track of all celebrities you defeated, and which celebrity you used to defeat them with, while playing Death by Elimination. If you do not save your game, all data here will be lost.

Save

Save your current game or overwrite an existing game at any time.

Load

Load a saved game at any point from the main menu.

Credits

This allows you to view the Celebrity Deathmatch team credits.

Options



To highlight the Option you wish to adjust, use the Up or Down Directional button. To accept all changes press the **X** button. To cancel all changes press the **△** button.

The following is a list of options that can be adjusted on the Options menu screen by using the Right or Left Directional button:

- Sound Effect – To adjust the volume of all sound effects.
- Music/Dialog – To adjust the volume of both music and celebrity dialog.
- Difficulty – To adjust the strength of the computer controlled AI.
- Vibration – Turn controllers supported by Dual Shock on/off.
- Wrestlers Intros – Turn on/off celebrity intros.
- Control Options – Select 1 of 4 pre-set controller configurations.

MATCH SETUP SCREEN



This is the main setup screen following all before mentioned game modes and is laid out in the following way:

On the left side of the screen you will see the Player 1 selection window adjacent to the Player 2 selection window, where both players can cycle through the available celebrities by using the Left or Right Directional button. Just below each celebrity name are the Stamina and Strength meters for the active celebrity. Stamina and Strength abilities will vary for each celebrity, affecting the way the celebrity performs in the ring. When your celebrity selection has been made, press the **X** button to lock in your celebrity selection.

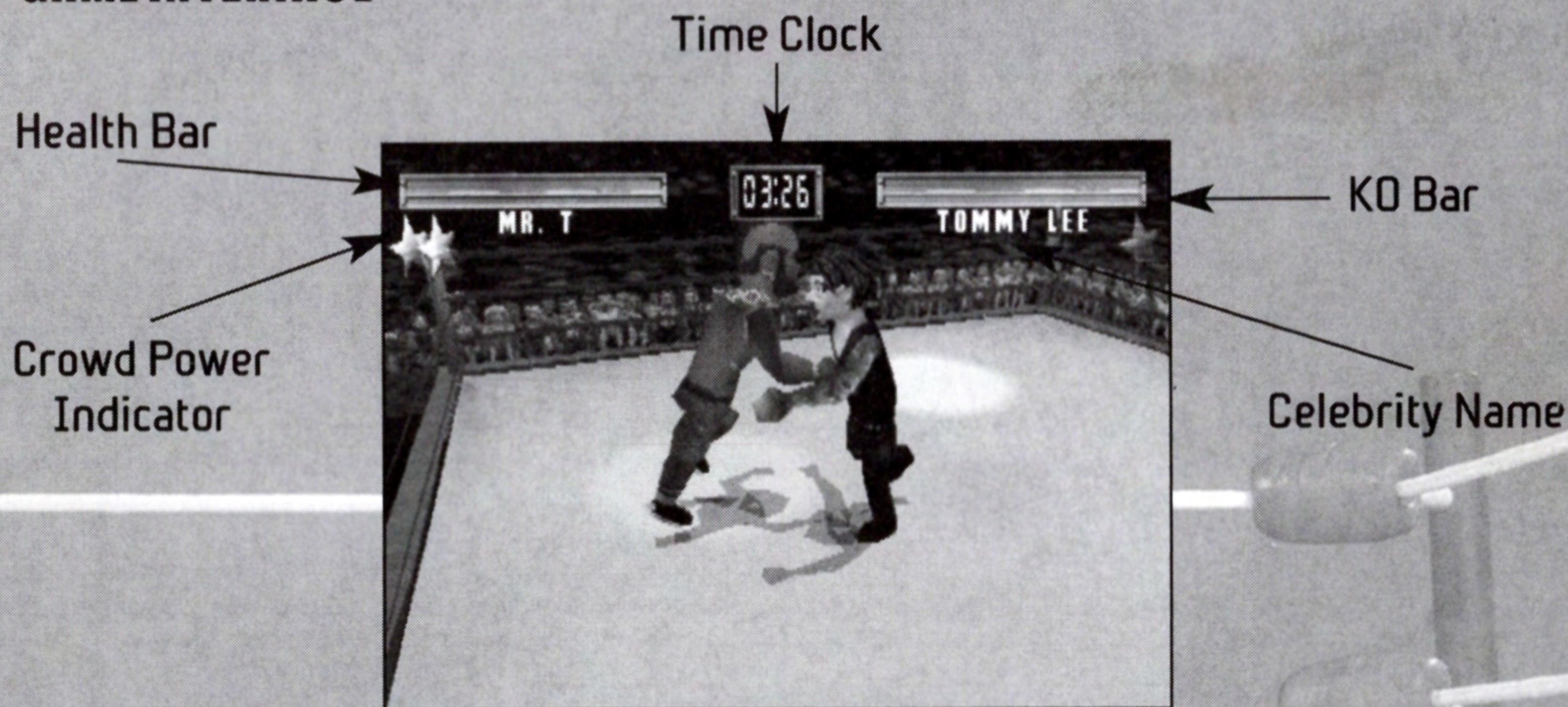
After selecting a celebrity, in some modes, you will be given the opportunity to select a ring type from the four available, and they are: Standard ring, Steel Cage ring, Cemetery ring and the Toughman ring. Use the Left or Right Directional button to cycle through the ring types and the **X** button to accept your choice.

The match Time Limit can be selected in most modes and gives the player the opportunity to set how long the match will last. The time limit choices are from 1-10 minutes, with the addition of a no limit option. If there is not a winner before the time

limit runs out, the match will end, in a Fan of Fandimonium finale, killing both celebrities. Use the Left or Right Directional button to cycle through the time limits and the **X** button to accept your choice.

Use the **△** button to go back to make any changes on this screen or to exit without saving changes.

IN-GAME INTERFACE



"Someone's about to get clotheslined!"

Health Bar - The Health Bar indicates the health level of your celebrity. Your celebrity's health decreases every time your opponent successfully executes a maneuver against you. The rate at which this bar drops is dependent on the move successfully executed against you. As time goes by, your health will slowly replenish itself.

KO Bar - The KO Bar shows how close a character is to getting knocked down or stunned. The KO bar recoups quickly if the character is on the ground. Like in real boxing, taking a moment to rest on the ground before getting up is beneficial. If you are getting repeatedly pummeled, your KO bar will quickly hit rock bottom. The

speed at which your KO recovers depends on your overall health. Tap the ○, △, □ and × buttons to recover quicker when knocked down.

Power Indicator – At any given time there will be 1 to 3 stars by a character's name. The number of stars represents the level of wrestling moves the player can perform. Having more stars present unlocks special moves. The number of stars is determined by the opponent's health, and the character's crowd energy. The brightness of the stars shows the amount of crowd energy the wrestler has.

The crowd energy is how much energy, drawn from the crowd, the celebrity has. This energy drops with time, but increases with crowd-pleasing moves and performance. Taunting your opponent makes him look bad, lowering his crowd energy. You may alternatively take a moment to perform a "crowd call" increasing your own energy.

Celebrity Name – This indicates the name of your celebrity. Keep in mind, Player 1 is on the left and Player 2 is on the right.

Time Clock – As the match goes on, the time clock continues to count down. If the time clock reaches zero before the match is decided, the match will end in a Fan of Fandimonium finale, killing both celebrities.

Death Match Action

Objective

The objective is simple; Eliminate your enemy through any means possible. Utilize the dozens of attack combinations for each celebrity as well as the many ringside weapons, to bring your opponents to their knees.

Fatalities

After an opponent is defeated, there will be a short period of time where the opponent will stand, stunned, before collapsing for good. During this period of time, the player may press a secret button combo to perform a "fatality - coup de gras".

As a reward, upon completing Death by Elimination mode, the secret button combo for the winning character is revealed. Completing it a second time, fatality combo #2 is also given.

Combat Notes

- ★ Repeated successful grabs are limited by a grab timer. Attempting to grab an opponent too often will always fail.
- ★ Repeated stomps are limited by a stomp timer. Attempting to stomp your opponent too often will always fail.
- ★ Taunting your opponent drains his crowd energy bar.
- ★ Calling the crowd increases your crowd energy bar.
- ★ Your KO bar rapidly decreases as you are hit. If it reaches 0, you get knocked down. If it reaches 20%, you get stunned. Hitting the buttons repeatedly before getting up quickly recoups your KO bar.
- ★ Moves do much more damage against someone who's bounced off the ropes.
