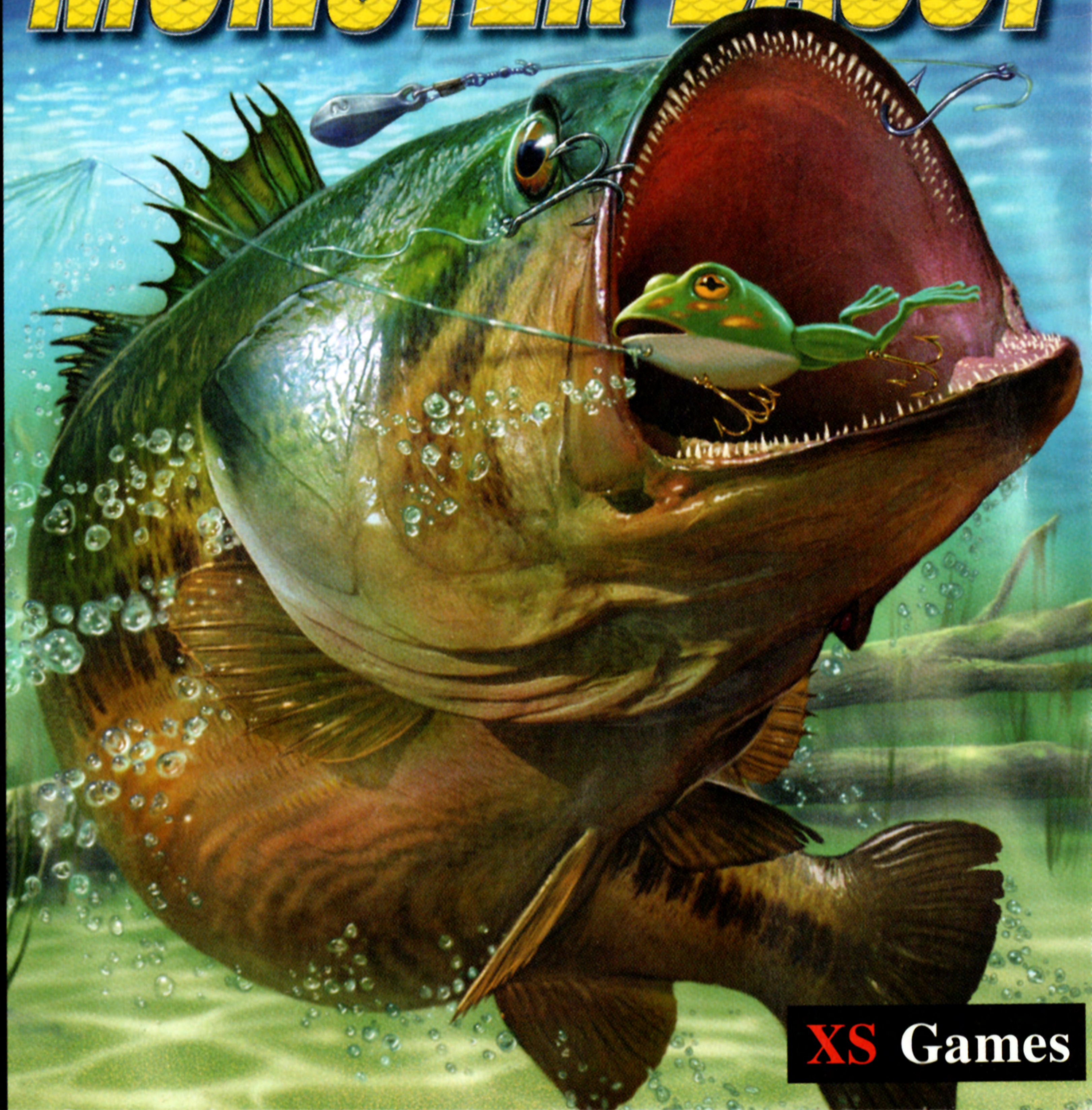



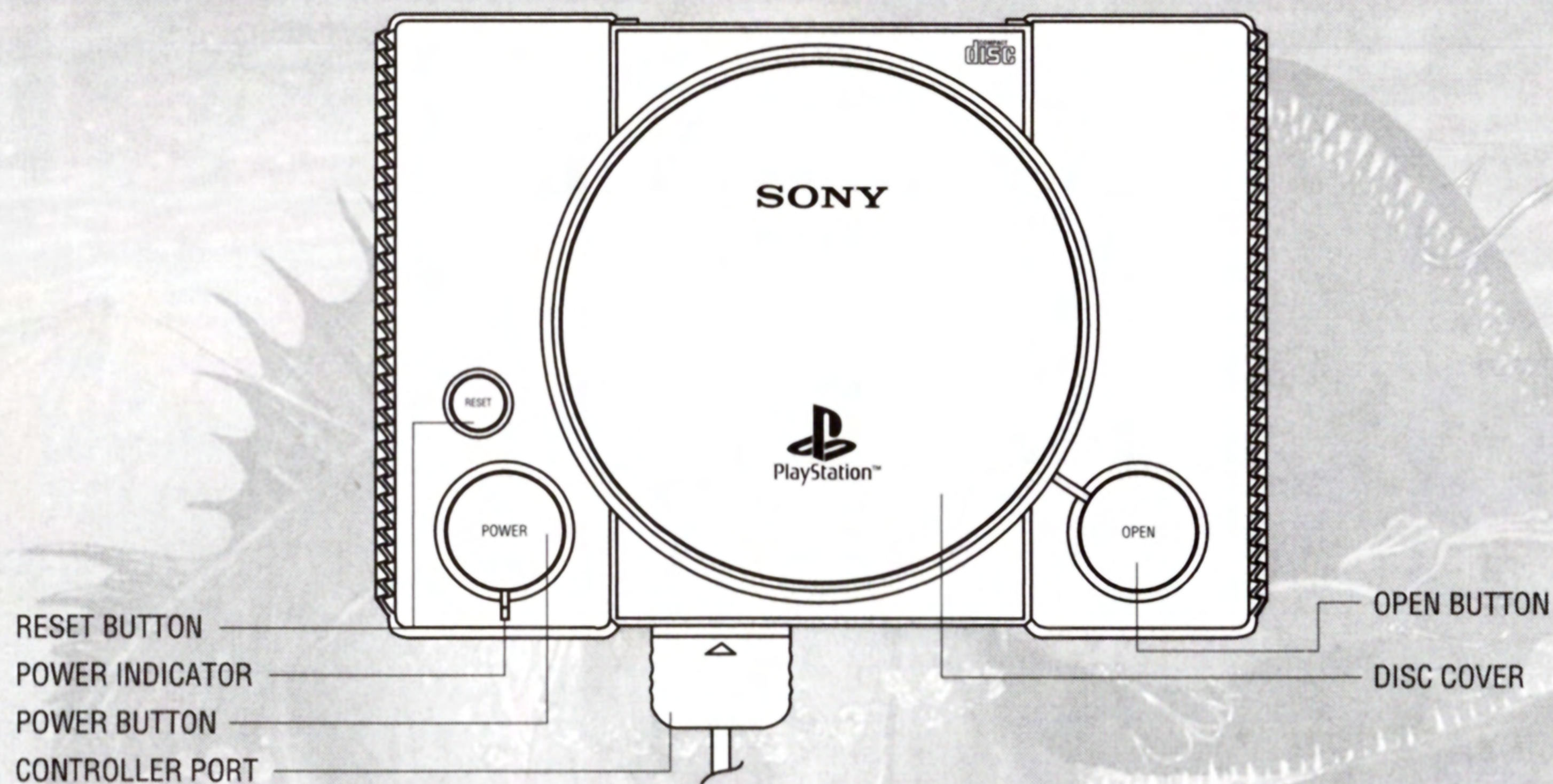
HANDLING YOUR PLAYSTATION DISC:

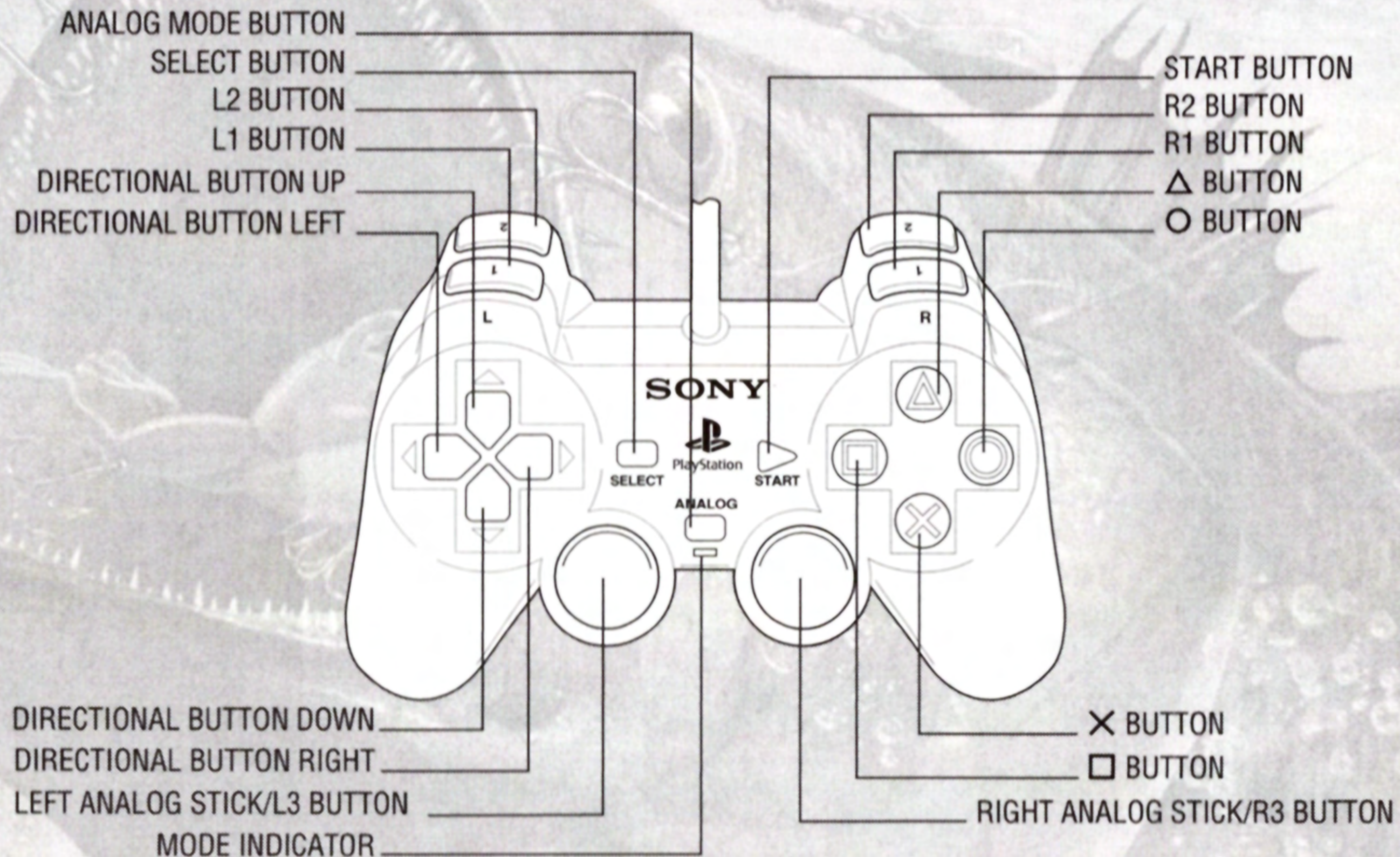
STARTUP INFORMATION



1. Set up your PlayStation® console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. **Make sure the power is OFF before inserting or removing a compact disc.**
2. Insert the Monster Bass!™ disc and close the Disc cover.
3. Insert the game controllers and turn on the PlayStation® console.
4. Follow on-screen instructions to start the game.

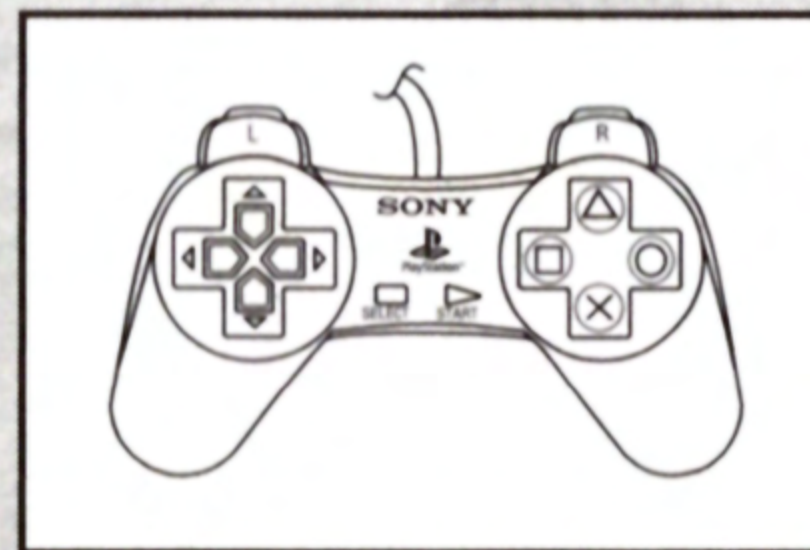

MENU SCREENS

CASTING SCREEN



- Elapsed time is indicated on the upper left. It indicates Minutes, Seconds and Tenths.
- Line Stress and Line Length are indicated on the upper right.
- Ranking during a Tournament Round and number of fish caught are on the lower right.
- Use the ⊗ button to cast your line and again to reel it in.
- Use the direction buttons to position the fisherman to the left and right at the Fishing location.
- After casting the line use the direction buttons to maneuver the bait left/right and closer to the surface or deeper underwater.



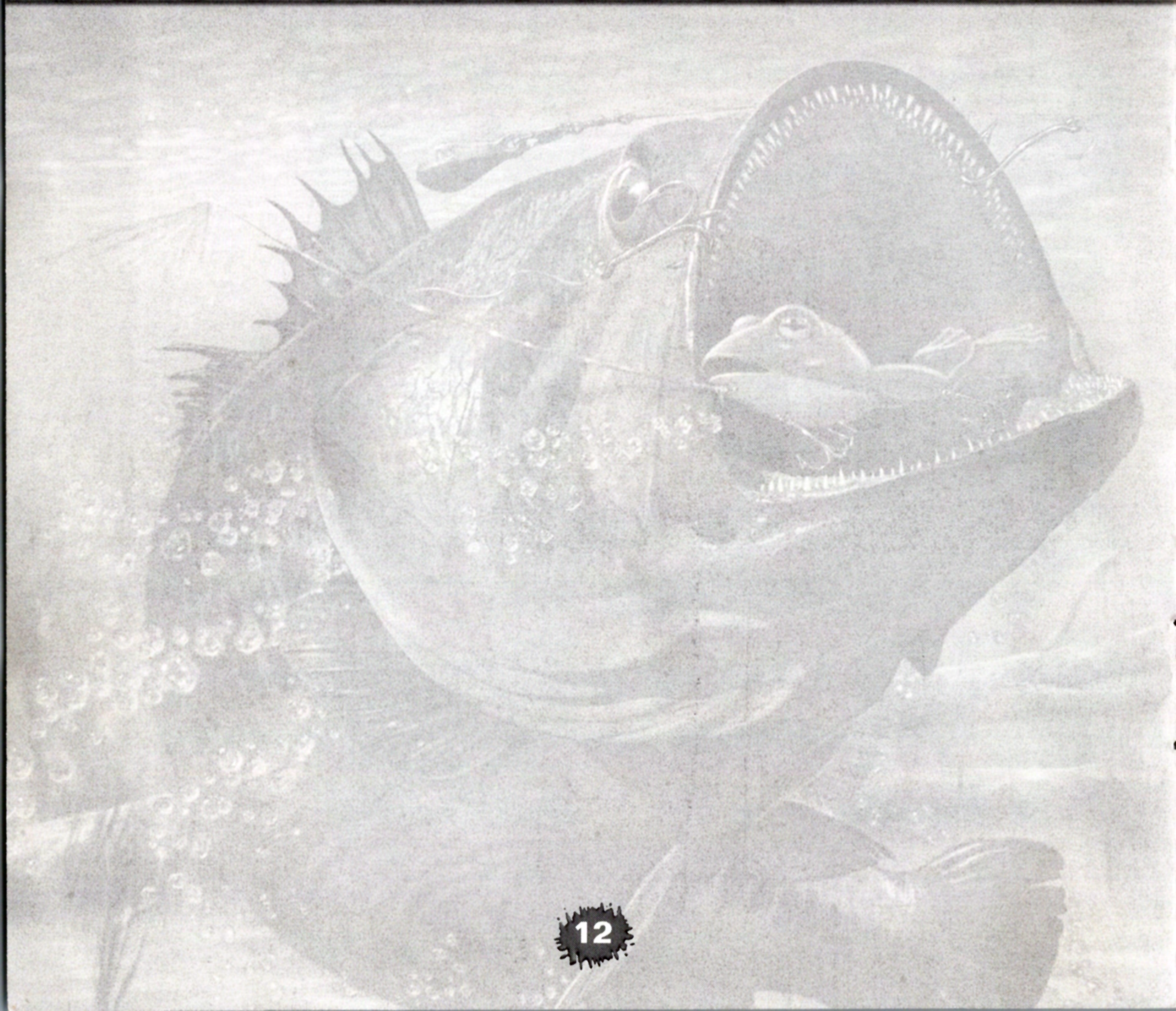
