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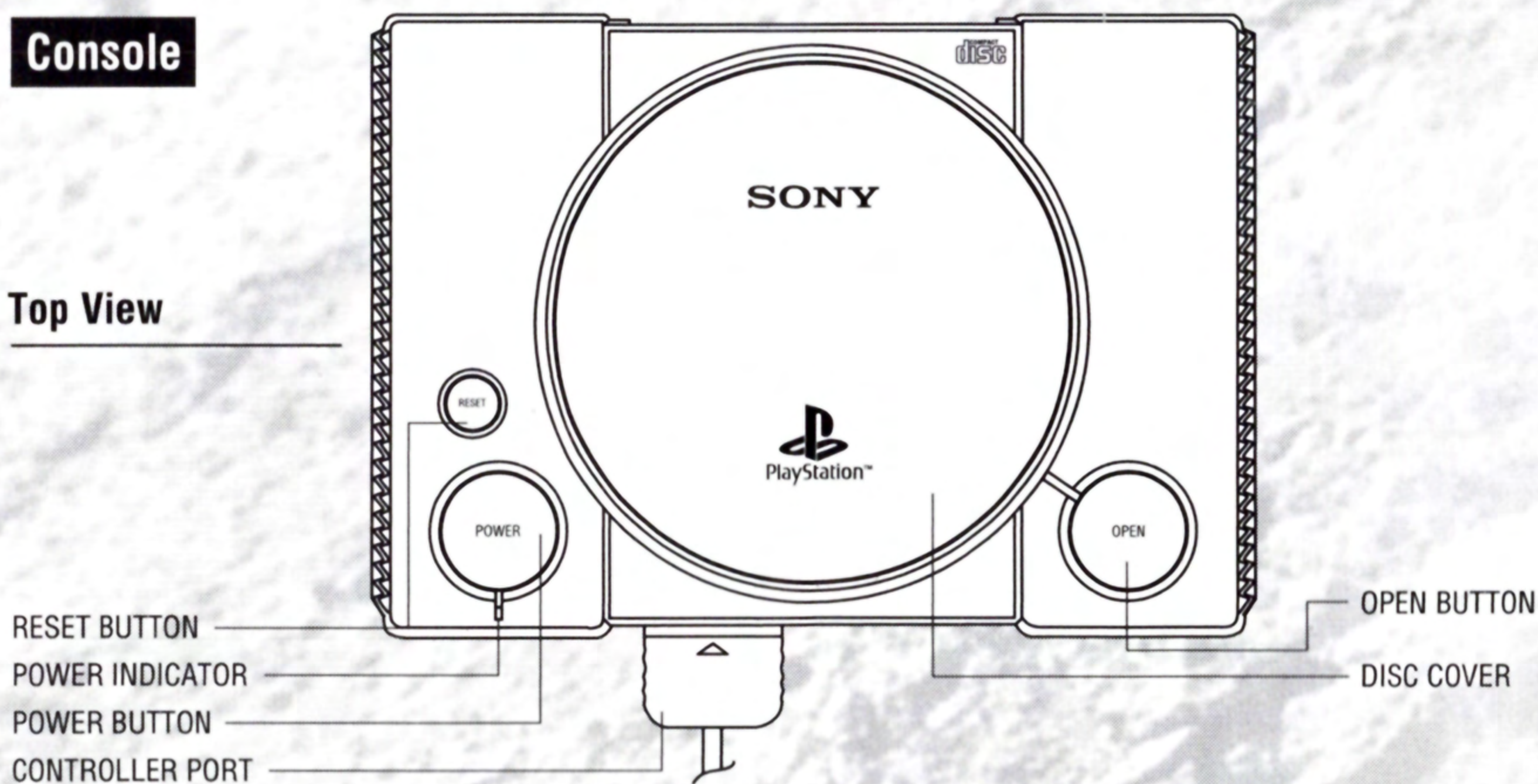
Getting Started

INSTALLATION

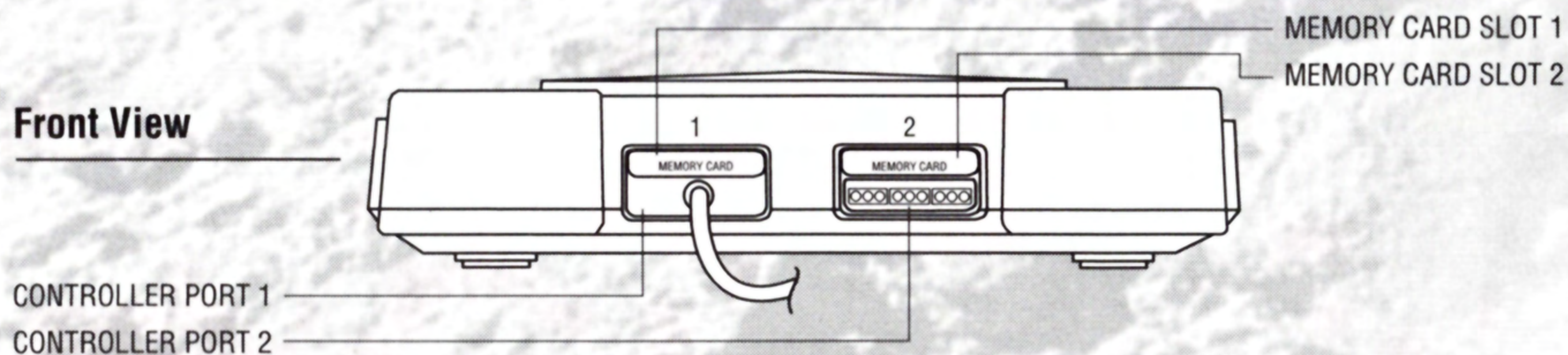
1. Set up your PlayStation® game console according to the instructions in its instruction manual.
2. Make sure the power is off before inserting or removing a compact disc.
3. Insert the Motocross Mania 2 disc and close the disc cover.
4. Insert game controllers and turn on the PlayStation® game console. Follow on-screen instructions to start a game.

Front View

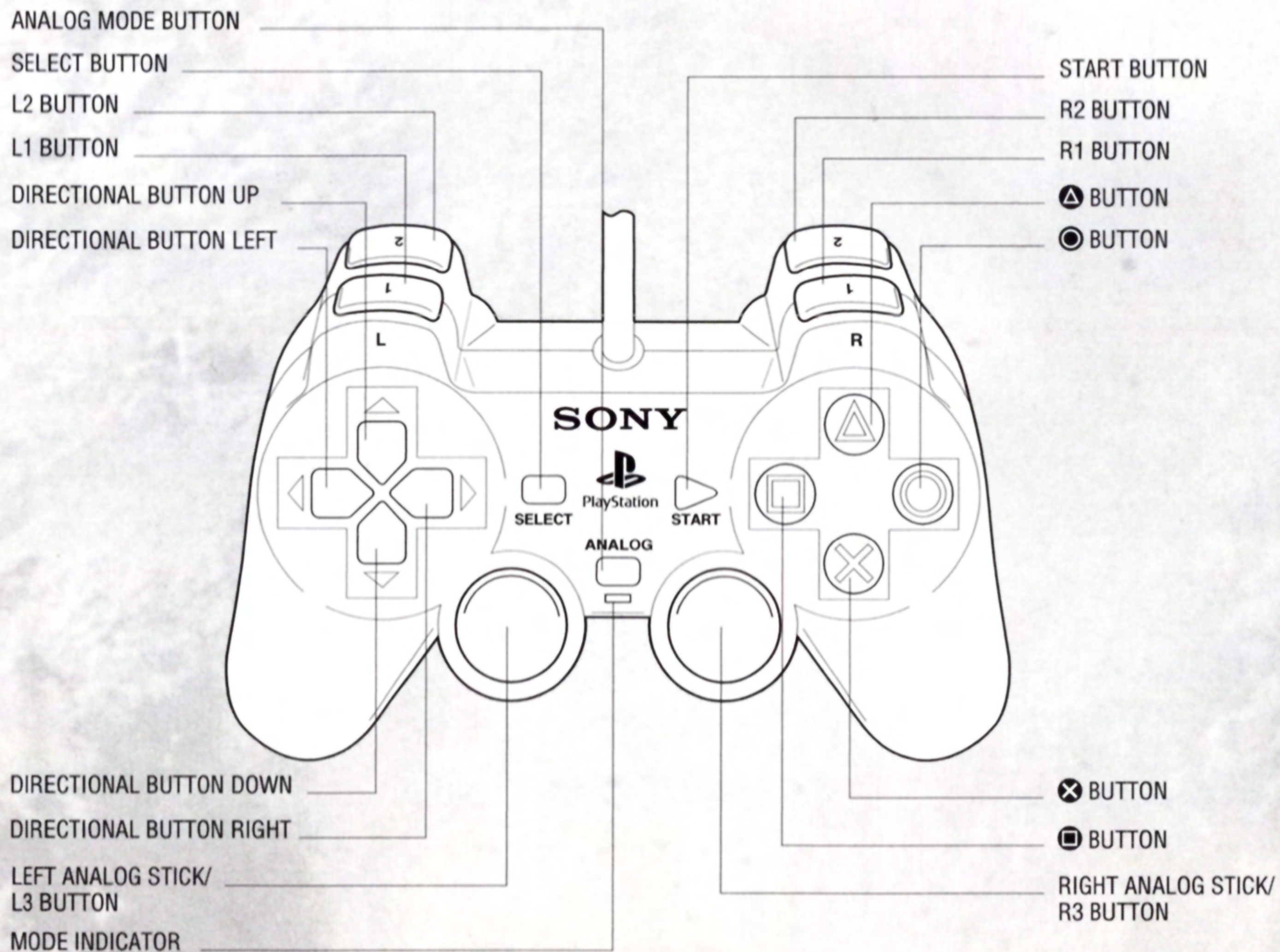


How to Play Motocross Mania 2

The default controls are listed below. You can choose from among several preset configurations in the Controller section of the Options screen. To choose an alternate configuration, select Options from the Main Menu screen, select Controller 1 or 2 (as applicable) and then choose the desired configuration.

Introduction

Motocross Mania 2 is an all out dirt bike thrash. With Arcade you can get right into the action. Whether you want just a quick race or the full Career treatment, it's all here.

Main Menu

The Main Menu is where you can choose game modes and access the Options screen.

ARCADE: This allows you to select a track, skill level and bike so you can get into the action right away.

CAREER: Choose to compete in a Motocross Championship progressing through each of the three difficulty levels.

TRACK EDITOR: Create and race your own track. And, you can save it too!

OPTIONS: See the Options Section.

CREDITS: See who all the great people are who worked so hard to bring you Motocross Mania 2.

<<Arcade>>

In **ARCADE** you have the following options: Select **SINGLE RACE, PRACTICE, OR RECORDS.**

SINGLE RACE

1 OR 2 PLAYERS: Choose between 1 or 2 players. (2 Players option is only available if 2 controllers are connected to the console.)

Select **GENDER:** Choose between Male and Female.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Choose between Amateur, Semi Pro and Professional levels of difficulty.

Select **TRACK** to race: Choose between 16 different tracks for each level of difficulty.

Select **NUMBER OF LAPS:** Choose between the options presented.

Select **BIKE**: Choose the bike to race. Select from 5 different bikes in the 125cc class for Amateur and Semi-Pro. Select from 5 different bikes in the 250cc class for the Professional levels.

Select **BIKE SETUP**: Adjust Suspension, Exhaust and Brakes.

RACE: Select to race the track.

PRACTICE

This option allows you to make the same selections as in Single Race but without having to race against any opponents.

RECORDS

This option allows you to view the best course records and lap records for each track.



<<Career>>

In **CAREER** you race, bump, jump and grind your way through an entire championship. The following options are available to the racer:

Select **NEW RIDER** or **LOAD RIDER**. If you select **LOAD RIDER**, then you will be able to load previously saved rider information.

After selecting **NEW RIDER**, you will be asked to enter a name. Use the up and down directional buttons to enter letters or numbers in the name. Use the left and right directional buttons to move the cursor, and to add a space.

Select **GENDER**: Choose between Male and Female.

Select **BIKE**: Choose the bike to race. As you move from Amateur to Semi-Pro and from Semi-Pro to Pro, you will have the opportunity to select a different bike to race. You may check a bike's specifications by highlighting a bike and pressing the  button. After highlighting the bike you desire to race, press the  button to advance.

You are asked to confirm your **BIKE** selection on the next screen. Select **YES** or **NO**.

From the **CAREER** screen, you can:

QUIT: Allows you to exit Career and return to the Main Menu.

SAVE DATA: Available only after each race.

PLAYER STATS: Displays your bike, Career Data (# of Wins and Rank) and difficulty level.

START/RESUME CAREER: Select to advance to the **SERIES** screen with the following options:

- **End Series:** Allows you to quit the series.

NOTE: When you quit a series, you will begin again at the next race in the series.

- **Save Data:** Available only after each race.

- **Series Stats:** Displays the standings (Points and Wins) of each rider.

- **Bike Specs:** This screen displays your bike's specs that you cannot adjust. Depending on your level of experience, you may see the bike's engine, exhaust, suspension and/or tires specs on this screen.

- **Bike Setup:** Adjust the bike's brakes. And, depending on your level of experience, you may also be able to adjust the bike's engine, exhaust, suspension and tires.

- **Practice:** Allows you to race the track without opponents. Lap time is displayed but number of laps is not. You may practice for as long as desired. Press the Start button then Quit to return to the Series screen.

- **Start Race:** Select to race the next track in the series.

<<Track Editor>>

In **TRACK EDITOR** you have the following options:

CREATE TRACK: Create a Race Track, then piece together your desired track.

EDIT TRACK: Allows you to edit or change the Tracks you have created.

LOAD TRACK: Load Tracks from the MEMORY CARD.

SAVE TRACK: Save the Tracks that you create! You can save 16 different Race tracks.

RACE TRACK: Race on the Race Tracks you have created.

- Select **One or Two Player:** If Two Player is selected then also select whether AI is On or Off. If AI is On, then 2 additional AI racers will race. If AI is Off, then the Two Players will race only each other.
- Select **Level of Difficulty:** Amateur, Semi-Pro or Professional.
- Select **Number of Laps** to Race: 5, 10 or 20.
- Select **Bike Setup**, if desired. See Bike Setup Section.

Race your track!

<<**Pause Menu**>>

During gameplay, press the **START** button to pause and unpause the game. When the game is paused, you will be given a number of options:

RESUME: Resume the current event.

OPTIONS: You can change:

- **Sounds:** Adjust the Sound and Music levels.
- **Vibration:** Turn vibration On or Off.
- **Radar:** Turn the onscreen radar map On or Off.
- **Laps:** Turn the onscreen lap counter On or Off.
- **Place:** Turn the onscreen place indicator On or Off.

RESTART: Restart the current event. In **CAREER**, the Restart option includes a counter.

The player may restart each series of difficulty 3 times. For example, you may restart a track or tracks up to 3 times while an Amateur, or 3 times as a Semi-Pro or Pro. After each restart, the remaining restarts are indicated on the Pause Menu.

QUIT: Exit the current event and return to the Main Menu.

<<**Saving and Loading**>>

Motocross Mania 2 requires **1 FREE BLOCK** of space in order to save. Make sure there are enough free blocks on your **MEMORY CARD** before commencing play. Motocross Mania 2 only supports **MEMORY CARD Slot 1**.

If you have a MEMORY CARD inserted upon boot-up, and a Motocross Mania 2 game profile is on the MEMORY CARD, the game profile will be automatically loaded. This game profile includes the previously selected language and any previously saved options and high scores. You may also **LOAD** a saved game profile by choosing **OPTIONS** on the **MAIN MENU**, and then selecting **LOAD OPTIONS**.

If you wish to **SAVE** your game, choose **OPTIONS** on the **MAIN MENU**, and then select **SAVE**. You may save up to 8 game profiles. If all 8 save slots are occupied, and you wish to save a new game, you will have to overwrite one of your previously saved profiles, or insert another MEMORY CARD.

If you have a MEMORY CARD inserted with no Motocross Mania 2 saves on it, you will be asked if you wish to save to the MEMORY CARD. Selecting **YES** will create a **SAVED GAME PROFILE**. If you have an unformatted MEMORY CARD inserted, you will be asked if you wish to format the MEMORY CARD. Selecting **YES** will format the MEMORY CARD, and create a saved game profile.

You will be prompted to **SAVE** records and options at certain points in the game, such as after completing a race in **CAREER** mode. Take advantage of these save points to ensure that your game progress and best laps are saved. Save after each **CAREER** race to ensure that your progress is saved.

Race Types

<<Arcade>>

How to start a race in **ARCADE**:

Select **1 OR 2 PLAYERS**: 2 Players option is only available if 2 controllers are connected to the console.

Select **GENDER** of racer(s): Choose between Male and Female.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Choose between Amateur, Semi Pro and Professional levels of difficulty.

Select **TRACK** to race: Choose between 16 different tracks for each level of difficulty.

Select **NUMBER OF LAPS**: Choose to race 3, 6 or 12 laps.

Select **BIKE**: Choose the bike to race. Select from 5 different bikes in the 125cc class for Amateur and Semi-Pro. Select from 5 different bikes in the 250cc class for the Professional levels.

Select **BIKE SETUP**: Adjust Suspension, Exhaust and Brakes.

RACE: Select to race the track.

<<Career>>

How to start a race in **CAREER**:

From within the **MAIN MENU**, choose **CAREER** and press the **X** button to advance.

Choose **NEW RIDER** or **LOAD RIDER** and press the **X** button to advance.

If you have chosen **LOAD RIDER**, then all riders saved to the **MEMORY CARD** will be displayed for you to choose from. Select the desired rider and press the **X** button to advance. The next screen that you will see will be the **CAREER** screen.

If you have chosen **NEW RIDER**, then you will enter your name using the directional buttons. After entering your name, press the **X** button to advance.

Select **GENDER**: Choose between Male and Female.

Select **BIKE**: Choose the bike to race. After highlighting the bike you desire to race, select the **X** button to advance.

You will be asked to confirm your choice of **BIKE** by highlighting **YES** and pressing the **X** button.

From the **CAREER** screen, highlight **START CAREER**, and press the **X** button to advance to the **SERIES** screen.

From the **SERIES** screen, select **START RACE**.

***NOTE**: If you quit out of a Career race you will be penalized with a last place finish for that race.

POST RACE: After each race in a **CAREER**, the **RESULTS** screen will appear. **FINAL TIME**, **BEST LAP TIME**, and **CAREER POINTS** earned are detailed here. Pressing the **X** button will bring you to a **SAVE** prompt, and then to the **CAREER STANDINGS** screen. Pressing the **X** button again will bring you to the **SERIES** screen for the next race. Here you will be shown the next track you will be racing on. You will also have the chance to alter your **BIKE SETTINGS**, if desired.

<<Practice>>

In **PRACTICE** Mode, you will be given true freedom to practice stunts and race maneuvers. Your lap time and stunt points are displayed but no other information. You may practice as often as you desire for as long as you desire.

Stunts

Stunts are performed by use of **R2**, **L2** and the **directional buttons**. The combinations are listed below. As you perform stunts, points are earned and your Power Meter gains strength.

RODEO HEEL CLICKER: R2 button + L2 button

NAC-NAC: R2 button

CAN-CAN: L2 button

SURFER SEAT STAND: R2 button + right directional button

CLIFFHANGER: R2 button + up directional button

POMMEL BAR: R2 button + left directional button

LAZY BOY: R2 button + down directional button

NO-CAN: L2 button + left directional button

HART ATTACK: L2 button + right directional button

SUPERMAN: L2 button + up directional button

SUICIDE CHICKEN: L2 button + down directional button

In **analog mode**, the **left analog stick** may be used in place of the directional buttons.

Options

AUDIO: Set the volume for sound effects and music. Select Stereo or Mono.

CONTROLLER 1 AND 2: Choose between 4 sets of predefined controller setups.

CAMERA VIEW: Choose between Follow or Shoulder camera views.

CENTER SCREEN: Use the directional buttons to adjust the screen.

LANGUAGE: Choose between English, French, German or Spanish.

LOAD OPTIONS: Load a previously saved profile (See the Saving/Loading section for details.)

SAVE OPTIONS: Save your profile (Career progress, best lap times, high scores.)

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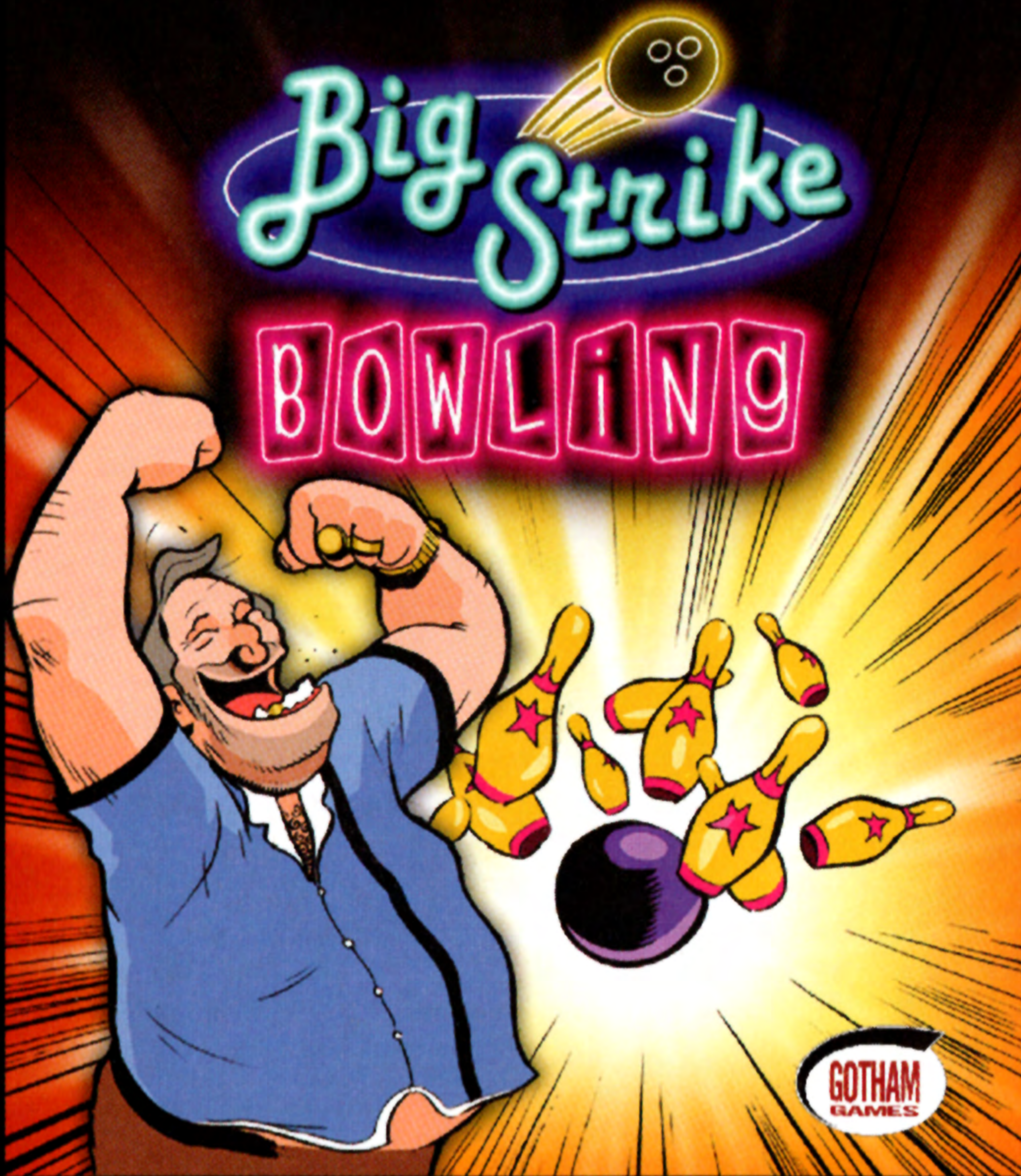


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
