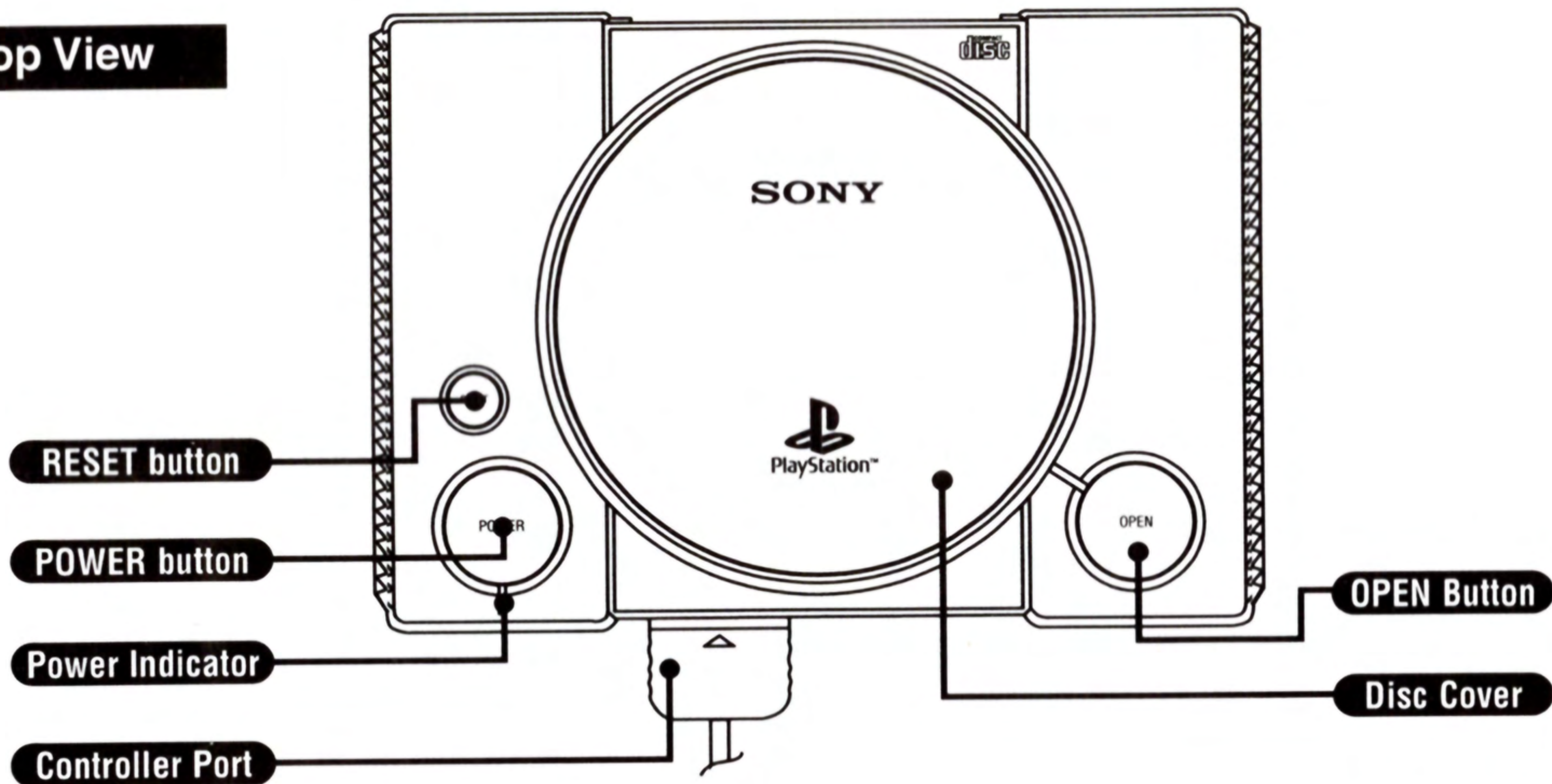

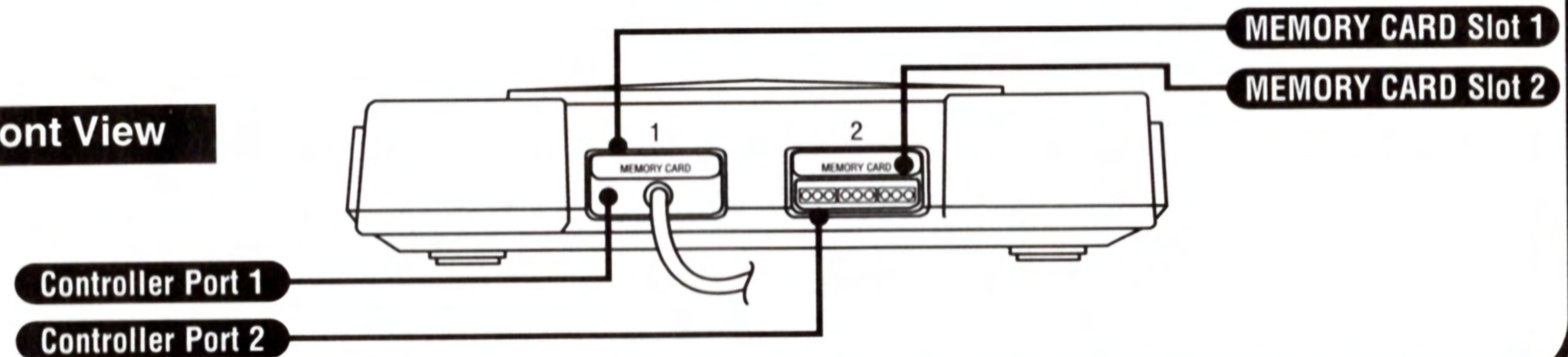


CONSOLE INSTRUCTIONS

Front View

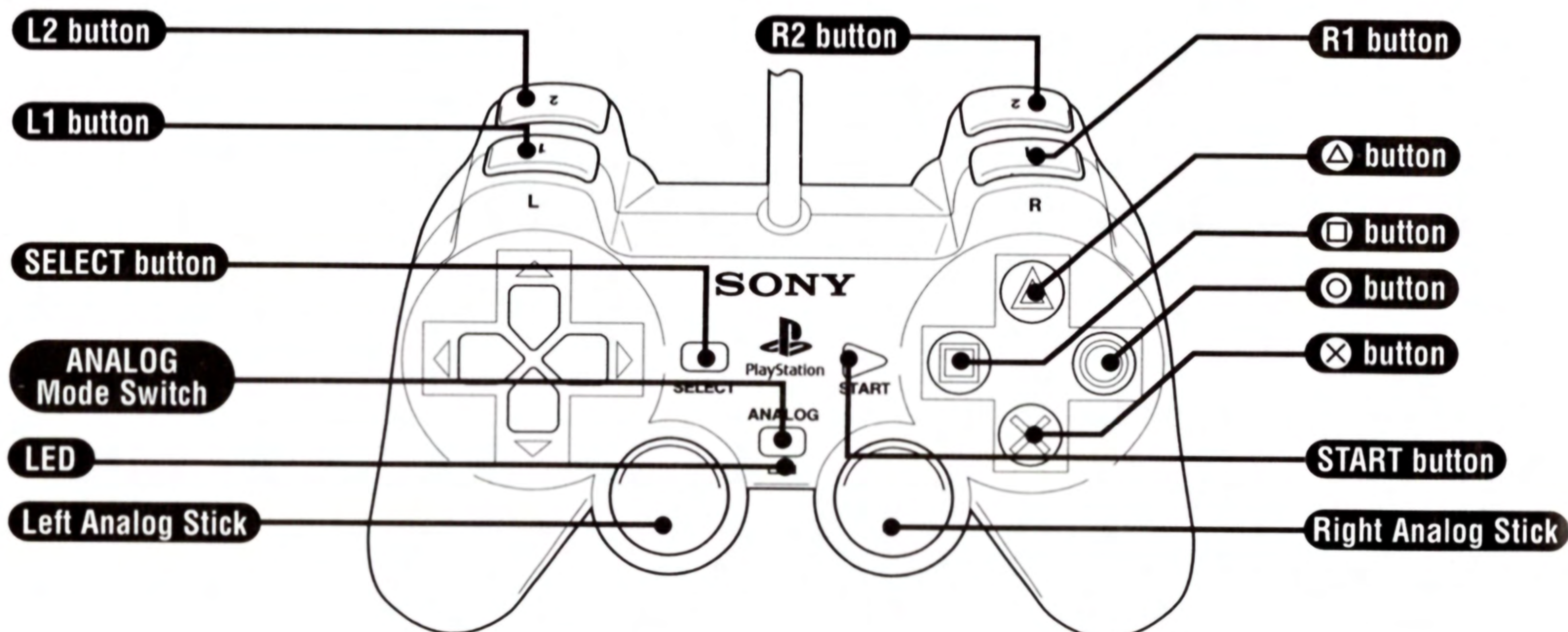


Set up your PlayStation game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the power is off before inserting or removing a compact disc. Insert the SNOWBOARDING disc and close the disc cover. Insert game controllers and turn on the PlayStation game console. Follow on-screen instructions to start a game.



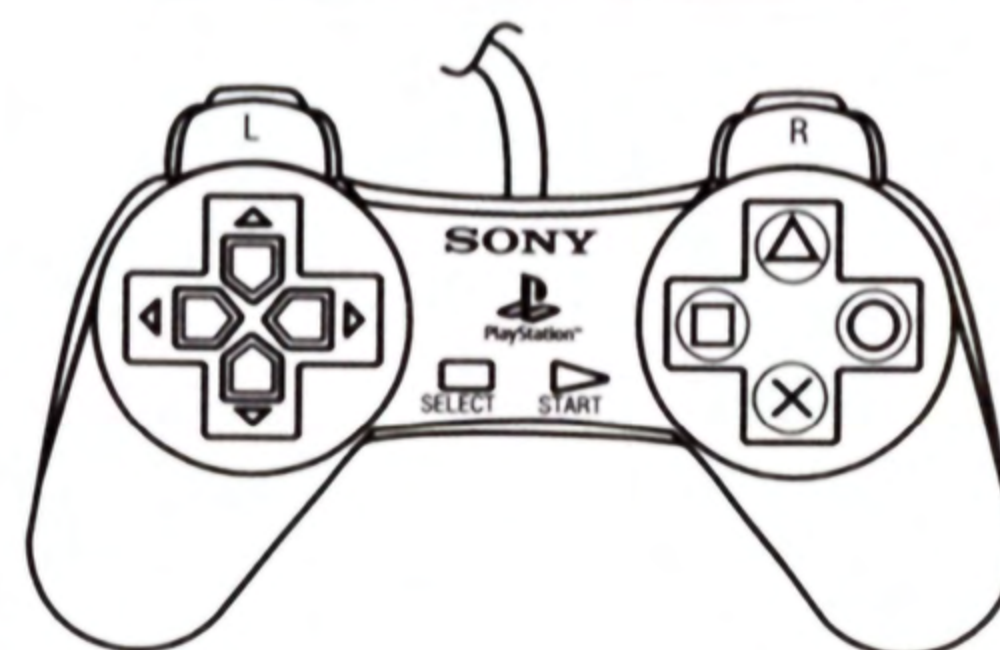

Note: R2 button, L1 & L2 button, SELECT button are not used in this game.

To quit a game, press the START button.

To pause the game, select EXIT.

To return back to the Mode, select Screen.



STARTING THE GAME

There are three selections on title screen: Race, Trick and Option. If no buttons are pressed, after a few seconds, the DEMO screen or the Tutorial will start. When in these screens, simply press START button to go back to TITLE screen.



RACE MODE

The racing mode is a timed race. If you reach the goal within the time limit, you clear the course, and a new course will appear. There are 3 modes available; **1P, Race** and **2P Mode**.

TRICK MODE

In trick mode, your tricks are scored on the basis of height, complexity, amount of rotation, variety of tricks and how well you land. There are 3 modes available; **1P, Race** and **2P Mode**.

PAUSE MODE

To pause the game, press the START button during the game.

OPTION MODE

Difficulty:

You can set the intelligence of the CPU players by adjusting the difficulty. The higher the number, the more difficult the game becomes.

Course Guide:

In Race mode, this determines whether or not the flags on the course will appear during the race. In Trick mode, this determines whether or not the trick point signs will appear on the course.

Sound:

You can change the sound settings between Stereo or Mono.

Vibration:

This determines whether or not analog controller vibration is active.

Handicap:

Enables or disables the handicap.

Save:

Saves game data.

Load:

Loads game data.

Ranking:

Ranking for all courses can be shown for both Race mode and Trick mode. Courses you have not played yet will not be shown.



RACE MODE

Select the course and play mode and then select your character. Use the directional buttons right and left to select the type of character, and use up and down to select the color of the character.

GAME SCREEN

Total Time
The current course time.

Time Limit
You must reach the goal before the timer reaches zero. However, you will be awarded more time for each checkpoint that you successfully pass within the time limit.

Position
Your current position.

Record Time
Current best score.

Course Guide
If you go to the options before the race and turn the course guide ON, flags appear on the course. These flags indicate where trick points are.

Speed
Blue flags on the right side of screen indicate your speed. The more flags there are, the faster you are going. Maximum speed shows as 5 flags on the screen.

TIPS

- 1 Following the course guide flags may not always show you the best way to get the highest record. Try to find the best way through the course to get the best time!
- 2 On the frozen slopes, you get more acceleration, but on fresh snow, you lose speed. On the fresh snow, press the button to speed up.

TRICK MODE

When the **X** button icon located on the left bottom of screen is flashing, you can pull a trick in the mid-air! Try the Indy grab, Tail grab and more to get a high score, and jump as high as you can and do cool tricks in mid-air!

GAME SCREEN



1 Total Points

The total current points that you have acquired.

2 Time Limit

Similar to the time limit in race mode, each trick you perform increases the time limit. If the time limit gets to zero the game is over.

3 Record

Current best points.

4 Course Guide

If you go to the options before the race and turn the course guide ON, arrows will appear on the course. These arrows will indicate where trick points are.

5 Speed

Blue flags on the right side of the screen indicate your speed. The more flags there are, the faster you are going. Maximum speed shows as 5 flags on the screen.

6 X button icon

When this icon is flashing, jump and pull a trick in mid-air.

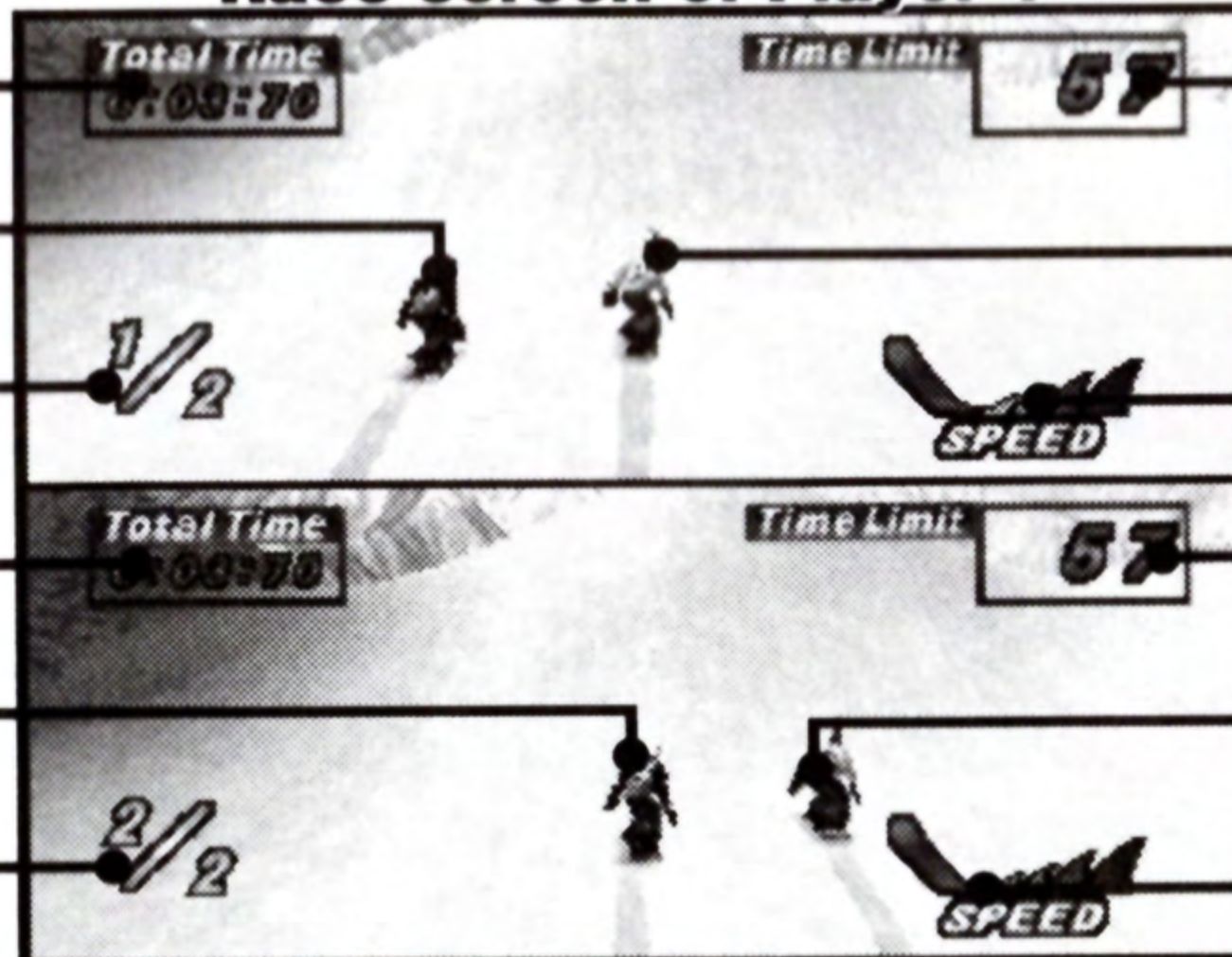
