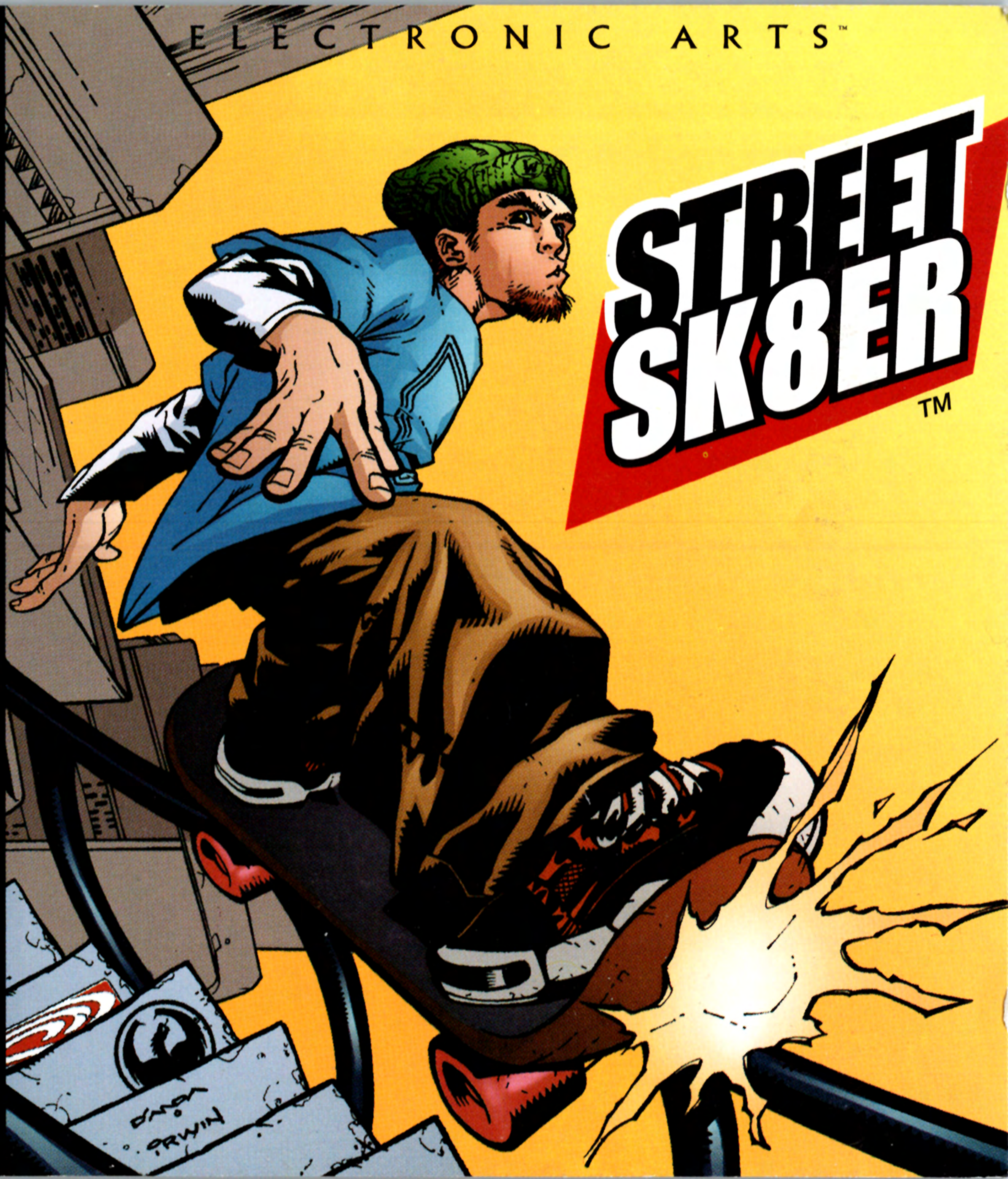

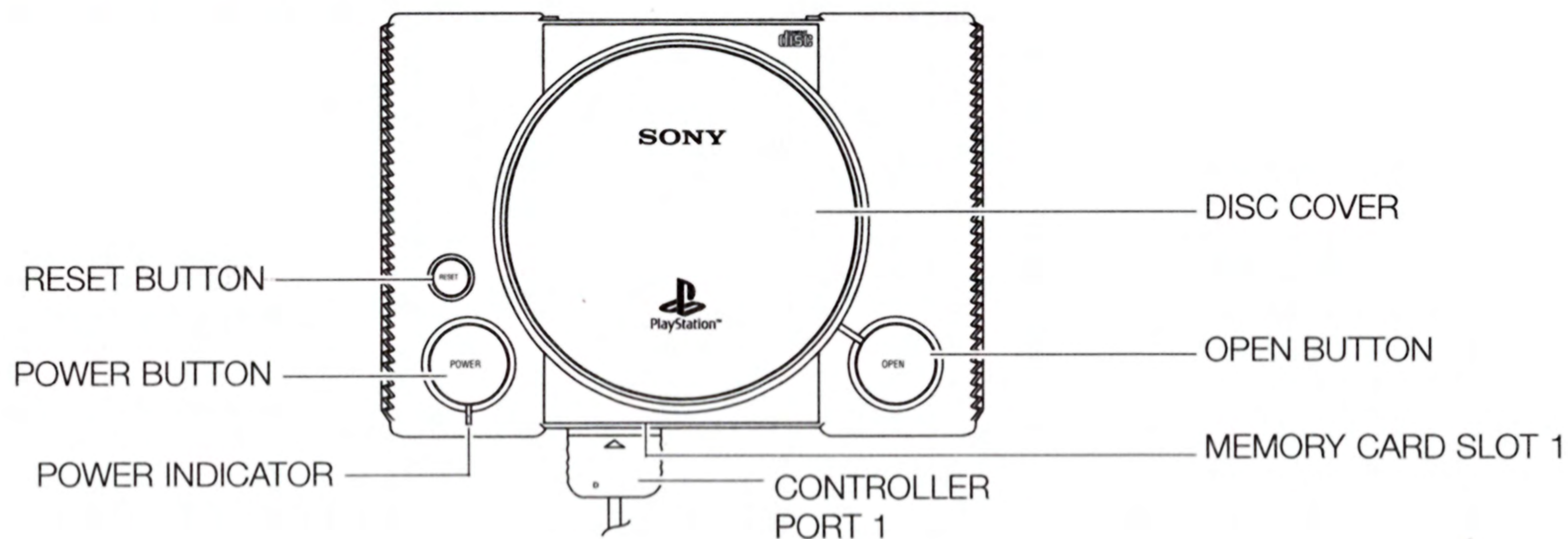

STARTING THE GAME

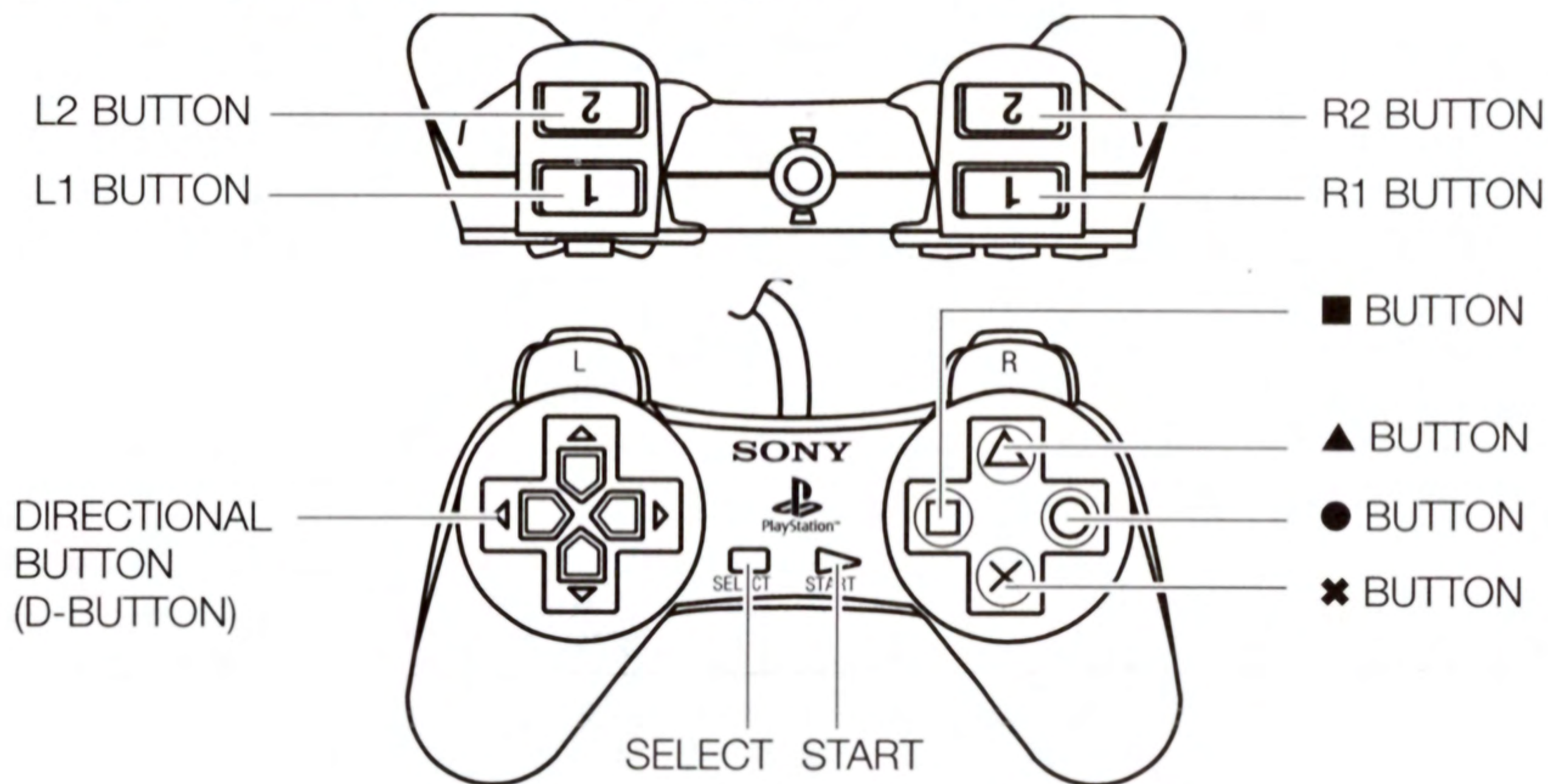


1. Set up your PlayStation® game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. **Make sure the power is OFF before inserting or removing a compact disc.**

4. At the Title screen, press **START** to access the Main menu (► p. 5).

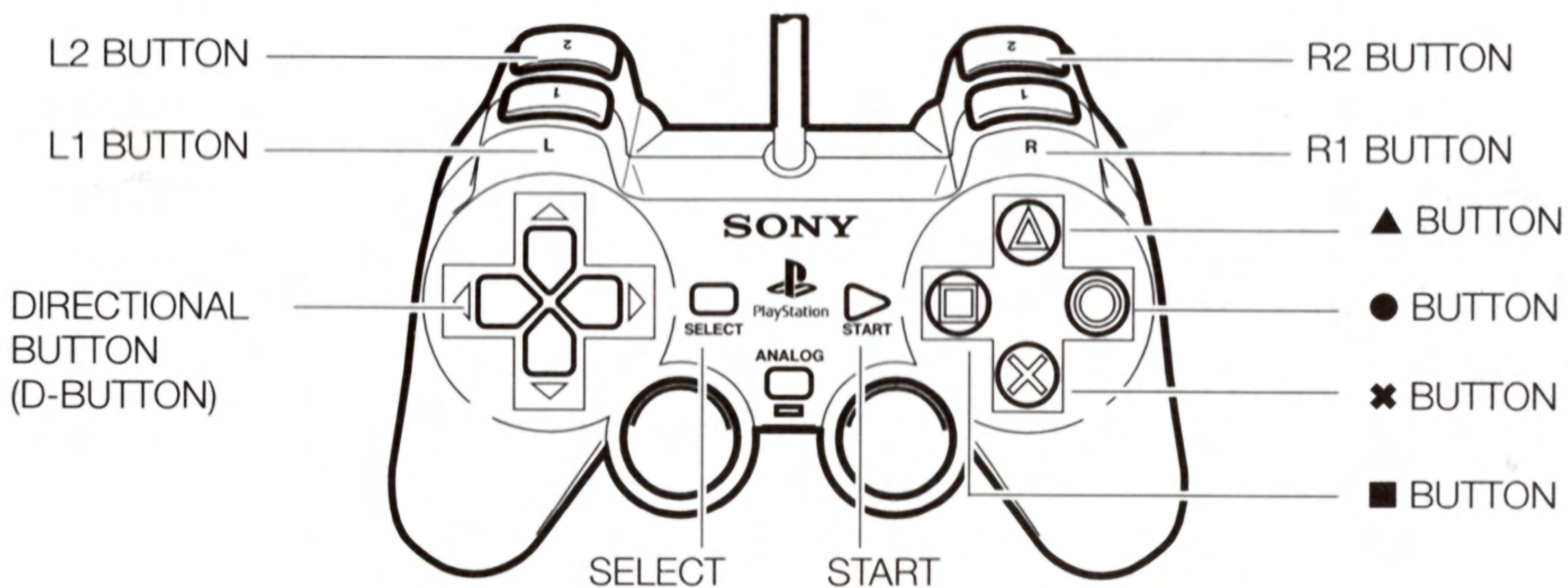

INTRO

Choose from one of four skaters, and start ripping in the Street Tour, Half Pipe, Bowl, and Big Air events. *Street Sk8er* is definitely the game you've been jonesin' for!

- * Original deck graphics from *Powell Skateboards*.
- * Slammin' soundtrack from *Epitaph* and *Capitol Records*.
- * **Street Tour** – Street and vert skateboarding combined in a high speed race against the clock. Progress to unlock routes, reveal hidden characters, boards, and more!
- * **Free Skate** – Turn off the clock to practice moves and learn the fastest lines. Leave it on and go for the high score.

GETTING STARTED

Main Menu

CONFIG SCREEN

At the Config screen, you can load/save a game, view the best scores, or access the Options screen.

➡ To select an option, D-Button \updownarrow to highlight it, then press **X**.

SAVE	Save game options, character data, high scores, and courses completed. (▶ <i>Saving and Loading</i> on p. 16.)
HIGH SCORE	Access the High Score Screen.
OPTION	Access the Options Screen. (▶ <i>Options Screen</i> below.)

OPTIONS SCREEN

➡ To select an option, D-Button \updownarrow to highlight it, then press **X**.

TIME LIMIT	Toggle ON/OFF to play with a Time Limit in Free Skate mode.
VIBRATION	Toggle ON/OFF to play with feedback on a Dual Shock controller.
SOUND MODE	Access the Sound Mode screen. (▶ <i>Sound Mode Screen</i> below.)
KEY CONFIG	Select controls for your skater.

SOUND MODE SCREEN

At the Sound Mode screen, you can tweak the game's sound options.

PLAYING STREET SK8ER

Play Modes

Street Sk8er offers up three unique play modes to test your sanity and showcase your skills:

- STREET TOUR MODE** Get ready to session a sick street course in a race against the clock, gaining points for tricks. Eat it and you pay with points!
- FREE SKATE MODE** Skate your favorite course with or without the timer.
- VS MODE** Pick an event and go head-to-head with a buddy in Vs. mode.

STREET TOUR

The Street Tour event combines street and vert skateboarding in a high-speed race against the clock where you perform tricks for points. Complete all three stops of the Street Tour (LA, NY, and Tokyo) to acquire more character attributes, max out your trick level, and unlock some new routes. Then play the Tour again with your newly acquired tricks to unlock a hidden character. Compete again with each new hidden character to reveal even more secret bonuses.

You must reach the set point value in order to clear each stage. You score points by landing tricks and finishing the session with time remaining. If you score enough points and to clear the stage, you earn attribute points that you can use to boost your skater's abilities. (► *Upgrading A Skater* on p. 10.)

BONUS ROUNDS

After each Street Tour stop, you enter a bonus round in one of the vert stages. Here, you have 30 seconds to rack up points that translate into bonus time for your next Tour stop. In the Half Pipe or the Bowl, bust a lot of moves to score big. In Big Air, your highest jump is the only one that counts, so don't hold back.

*** TRICK TIPS:** Try new tricks to get *first* trick points. Hit your best tricks and stay in constant motion. Blow a trick and you pay with points.

FREE SKATE MODE

Skate your favorite course, providing you've unlocked it in the Street Tour. Turn OFF the Timer on the Config screen and discover the sweetest lines of each course and the best hits to launch your favorite tricks. Leave the Timer ON to rack up points and get your name in the High Score screen for all your buddies to see.

VS MODE

Vs. mode allows two players to compete, taking turns, to determine just who is the king of the concrete.

- ➔ Pick a course (➤ *Selecting A Course* below), and challenge an opponent for bragging rights.

Starting Your Run

SELECTING A COURSE

At the Course Select screen, you can pick the location you want to skate.

- ➔ To select a course, D-Button ↔ to highlight the course, then press ✖. The Player Select screen appears.

★ **NOTE:** The Course Select screen does not appear in Street Tour mode.

SELECTING A SKATER

The Player Select screen is where you choose your skater. Each skater has different attributes, strengths, and weaknesses based on four categories: Jump Power, Cornering, Max Speed, and Acceleration.

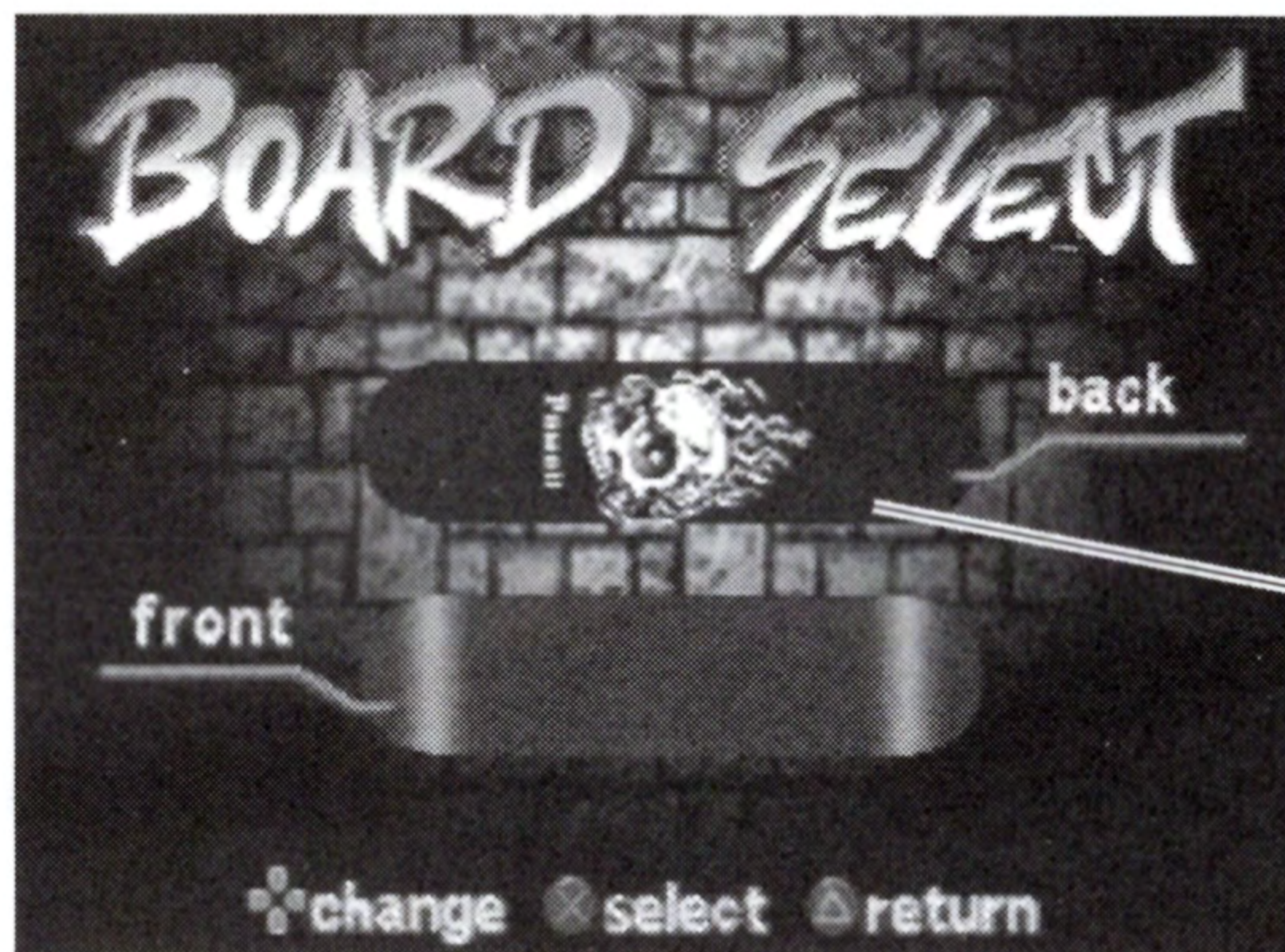

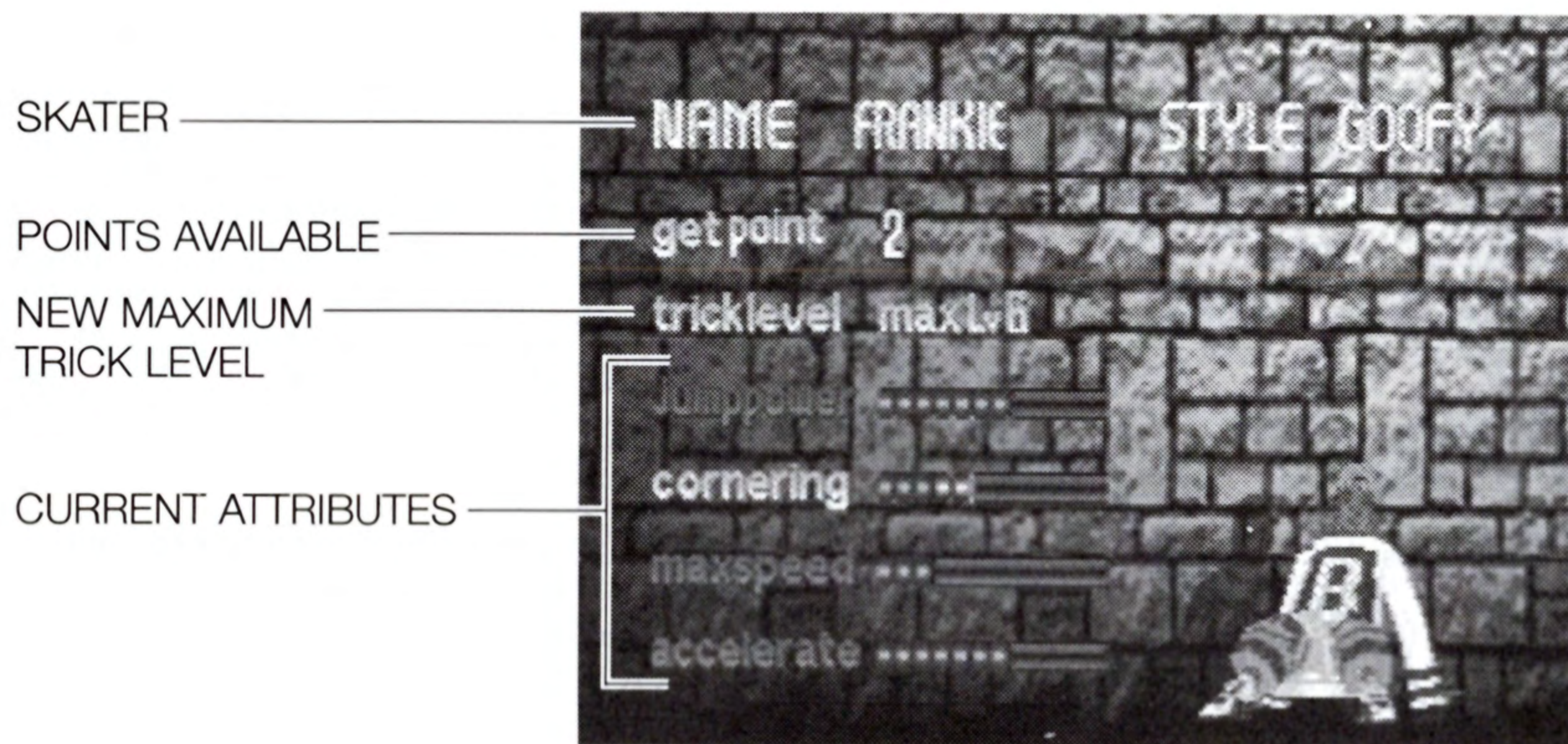

UPGRADING A SKATER

Each time you successfully complete a street course in Street Tour mode, you earn character attribute points that you can use to upgrade your skater's abilities.

- You can upgrade Skaters' attributes the first time through a Street Tour only.
- D-Pad \updownarrow to highlight an attribute, then D-pad \leftrightarrow to distribute your points. After distributing all your points, press \times to continue your game.





HITTING THE STREETS

After setting up your game, it's time to hit the streets!

Skating

Your rep is riding on your score. Earn points by pulling tricks and completing the course with time to spare. If you bail, you lose points.

- ➔ To build up speed, press and hold ●.
- ➔ To slow down, press ■.
- ➔ To perform an ollie, press ✕.

Display/Game Screen

You can check out the following stats at any time during your game.



TIMER	Time remaining to reach the next Checkpoint.
COURSE TIME	Total time of your current run.
HIGH SCORE	The most points accumulated on this stage.
TRICK SCORE	Current point total for your run.
CURRENT SPEED	Your current board speed. The higher the meter, the faster your speed.

Checkpoints

Checkpoints along the way. You begin with a limited amount of time and must reach the next Checkpoint before time runs out, or you're disqualified.

- ☐ When the TIME UP text appears, you have the option to retry the race.

Pause Game/Quit

- ➡ To pause your session, press **START**. The Pause menu appears.
- ➡ To continue your session, select CONTINUE.
- ➡ To quit the game, select QUIT.

Replays

Relive your sickest moves from a bunch of insane camera angles. If you finish the course, *Street Sk8er* automatically replays your session immediately afterwards.

- ➔ To turn slow motion ON or OFF, press ▲. To restore the replay to normal speed, press ▲.
- ➔ To pause or unpause a replay, press ■.
- ➔ To exit a replay, press ✕.

Tricks

In *Street Sk8er* you can perform hundreds of tricks with the various skaters. Ollies, kickflips, grinds, 360 flips, 1800's, backflips, handplants and tons more.

- Each skater has his or her own moves which get sicker as you progress. The higher your skater's Maximum Trick Level, the bigger the moves you can pull off.

To launch a jumping trick:

1. Skate up a wall or ramp.
2. As you reach the lip (or edge), press ✕ + D-Button ←, →, ↑, or ↓.
 - The trick you perform depends on your speed, the ramp, and the D-Button direction you pick.

To grind:

1. Skate beside a bench or rail.
2. Press ✕ and D-Button in the direction of the structure you want to grind.
3. Watch the sparks fly!

You can perform additional tricks from the switch-stance. Try skating switch and see what you can do!

- ➔ To switch your stance, press **L1** or **R1**.

COURSES

Street Tour Stages

LOS ANGELES

Get street smart and perfect your basic moves. Grind rails, hit mini-ramps, and launch huge air in the park. But what's up with those locked gates?

NEW YORK

Grind Central Park in the dark! In this insane tour stop, you'll find plenty of rails, benches, and long staircases to grind. Work the quarter pipe highway for crazy points.

TOKYO

This futuristic course is a skatepunk's dream! Huge jumps, tons of rails, plexi-glass walls, and a narrow bridge over a water trap are just some of things you'll find in Tokyo. Keep an eye on the Timer while you're busting moves, because it's the toughest course in the game.

Vert Stages

HALF PIPE

The ultimate pipe!!! Trick points convert to Bonus Time after riding the pipe in the Street Tour.

BIG AIR

In the Big Air, the goal is height, not style. Instead of pulling a buttload of tricks, build up your speed and work on nailing the highest possible air. Your biggest air determines your Bonus Time for your next Street Tour stop.

BOWL

The Bowl rules because you can pump from trick to trick, make clean landings, and get mega air. As in the Half Pipe, the goal here is to score as many moves as you can before time runs out. Every point counts toward Bonus Time.

SAVING AND LOADING

As you progress through the game and build up the abilities of your skaters, you'll want to save your game data.

*** NOTE: Never insert or remove a memory card while loading or saving files.**

- After completing a Street Tour stage and distributing your attribute points, the Save? screen appears.

To save a game in progress:

- 1.** Select YES. The Slot Select screen appears.
- 2.** Highlight the Memory Card Slot you want to save to, then press **✕**.

To save settings, high scores, characters, and courses completed:

- 1.** From the Main menu, select CONFIG, then select SAVE. The Save Slot Select screen appears.
- 2.** Highlight the Memory Card Slot you want to save to, then press **✕**. The Save screen appears.
- 3.** Press **✕** to save your game data.

To load a saved game:

- 1.** From the Main menu, select CONFIG, then select LOAD. The Load Slot Select screen appears.
- 2.** Highlight the Memory Card Slot you want to load from, then press **✕**. The Load screen appears.
- 3.** Press **✕** to load the saved game data.

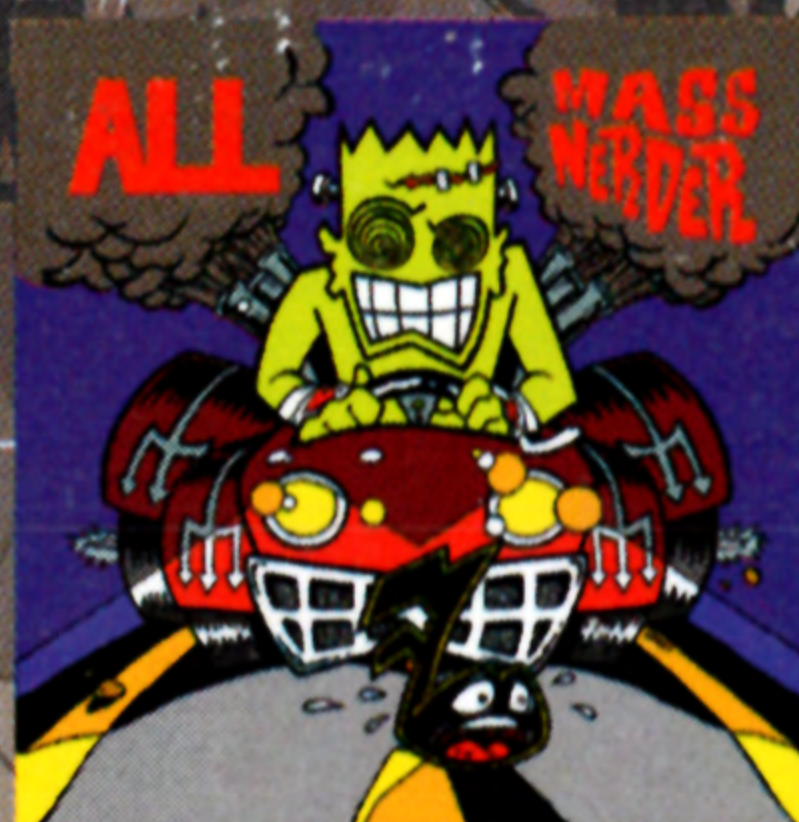
