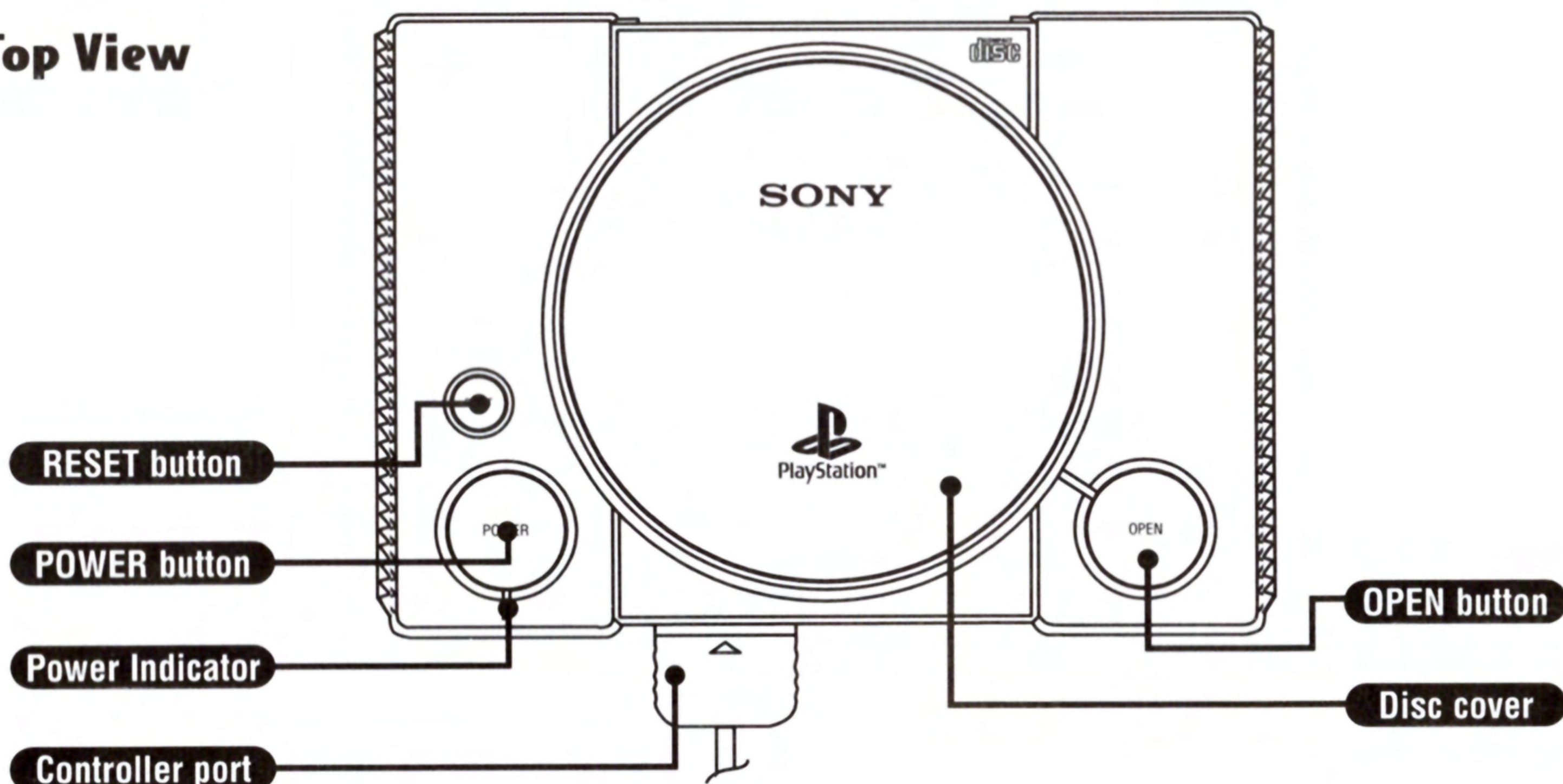

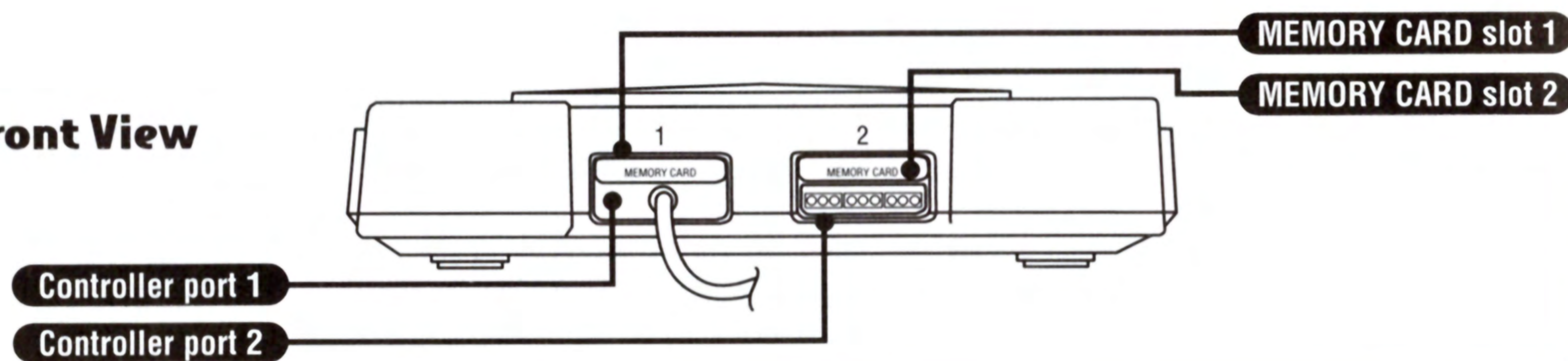

Front View

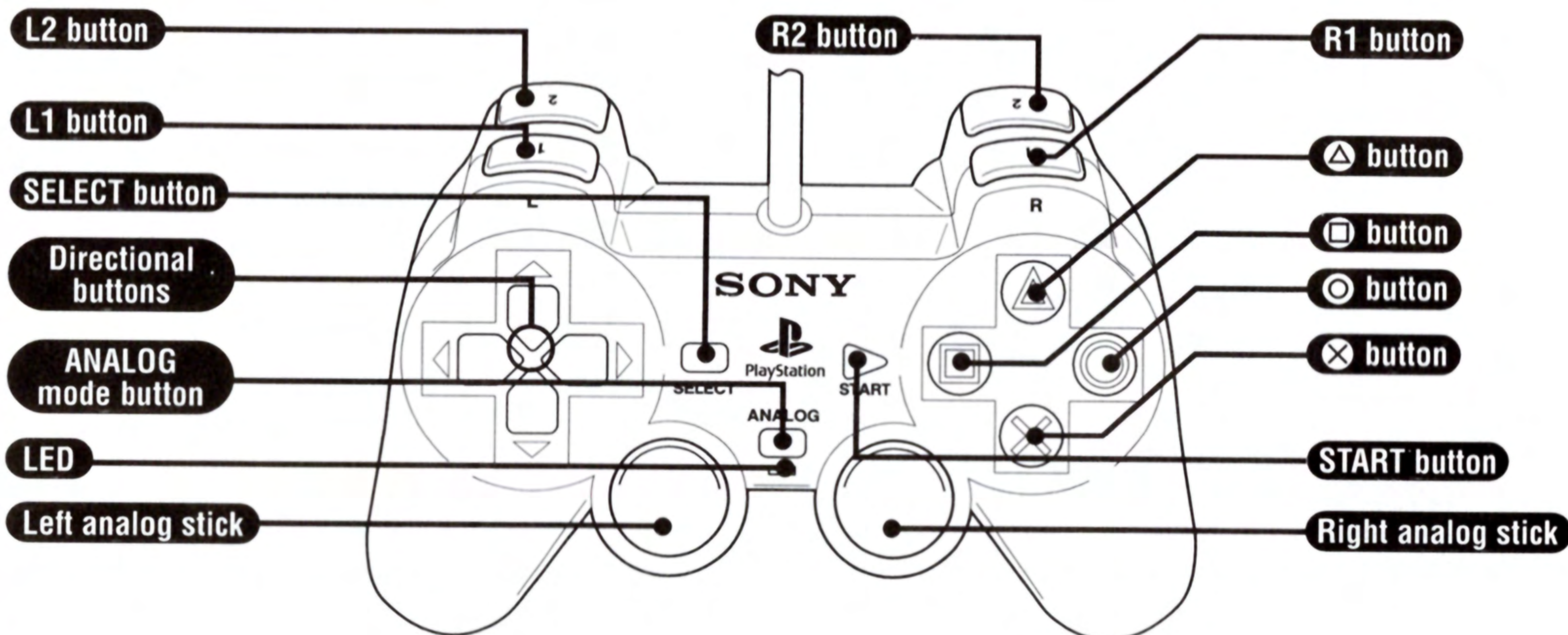


Set up your PlayStation game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the power is off before inserting or removing a compact disc. Insert the TENNIS disc and close the disc cover. Insert game controllers and turn on the PlayStation game console. Follow on-screen instructions to start a game.

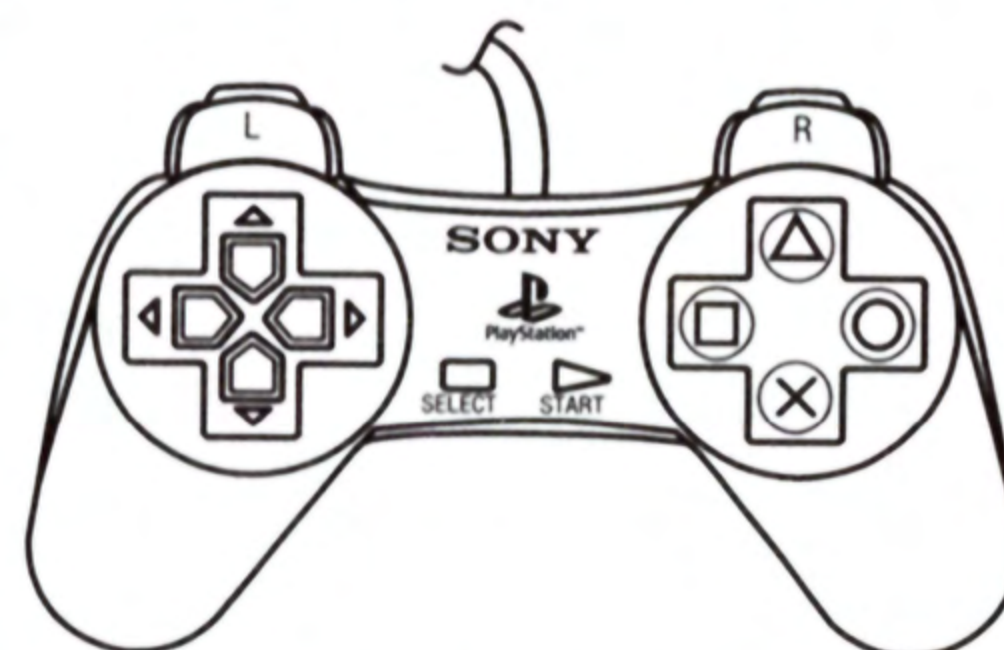

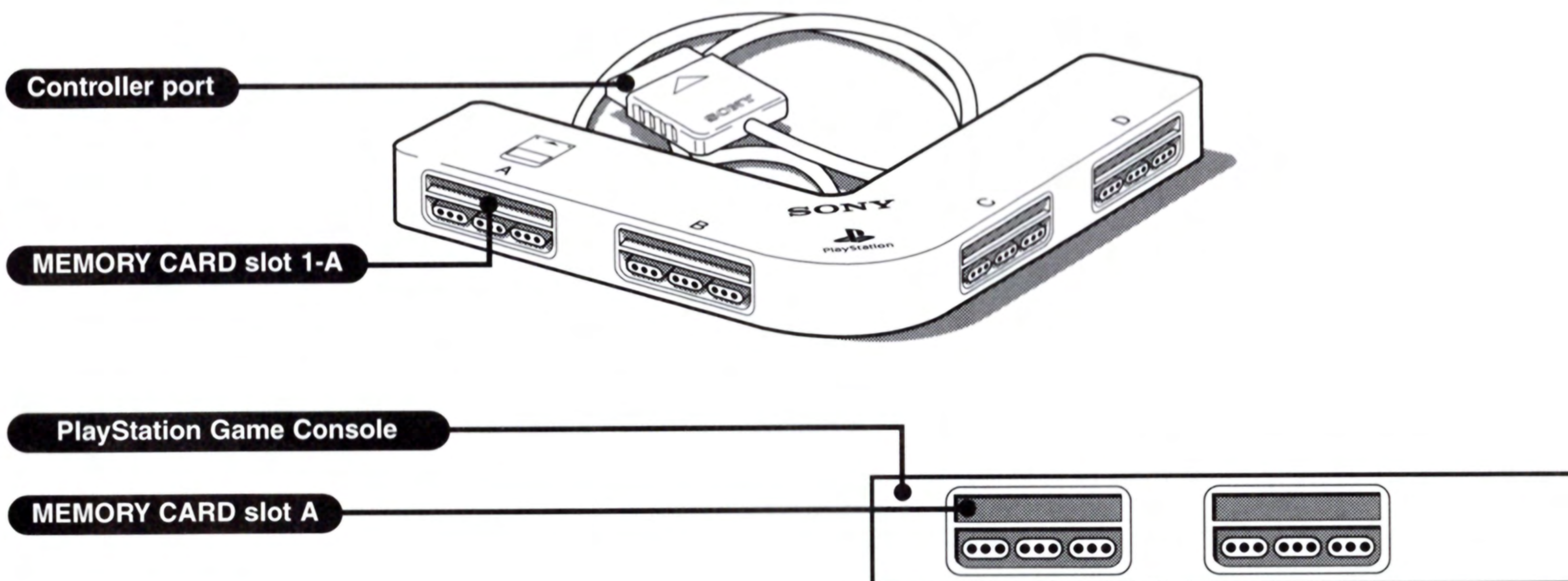

MULTITAP

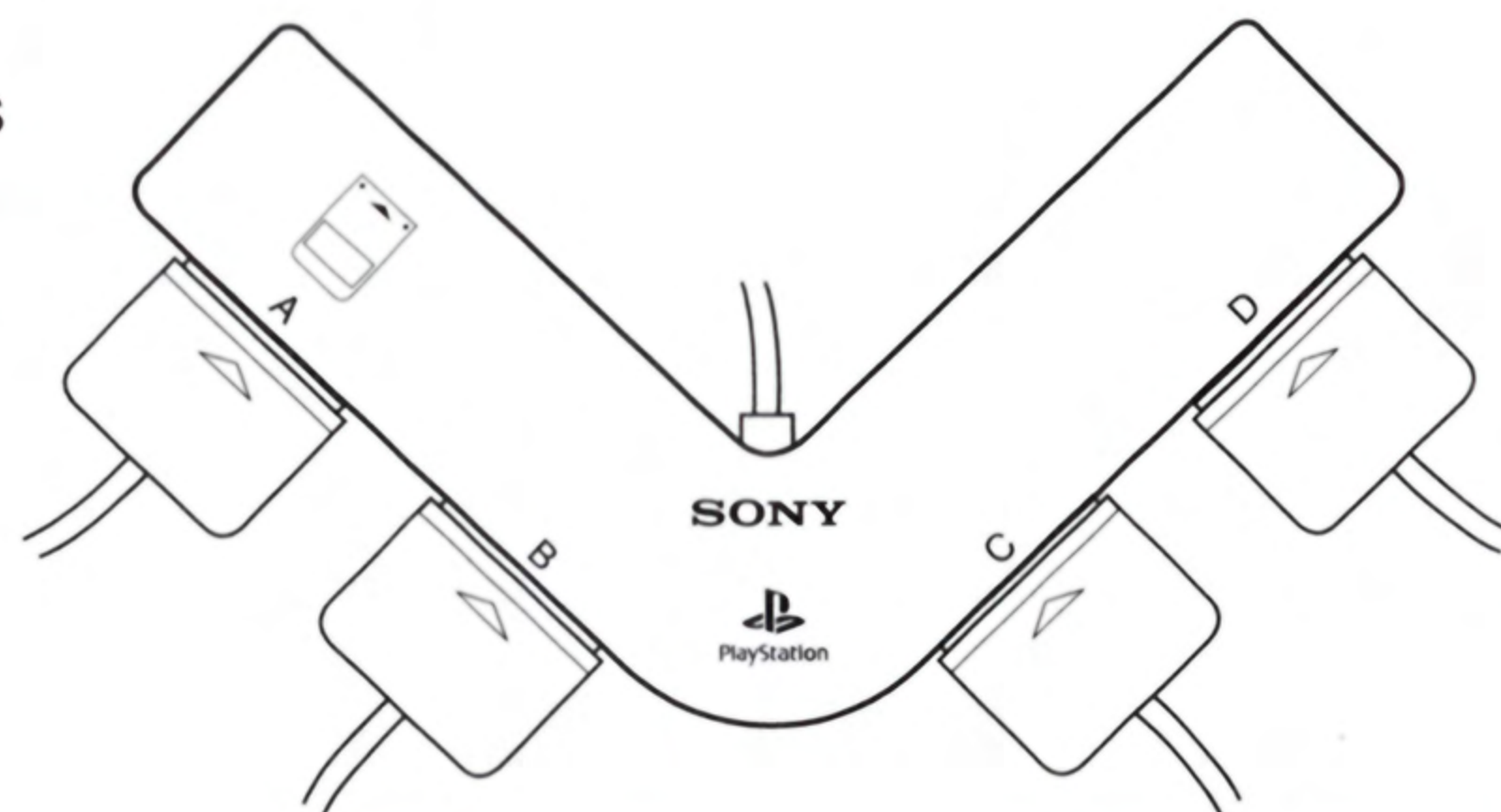
The following diagram illustrates when a Multitap (sold separately) is connected to Controller port 1 or 2 of the PlayStation® game console.

- PRECAUTIONS FOR USING THE MULTITAP -

Connect the Multitap to Controller port 1 or Controller port 2. Next, connect the controllers to the controller ports on the Multitap. When the Multitap is connected to Controller port 1, always make sure to connect a controller to Controller port 1-A on the Multitap first and then connect additional controllers to each of the Controller port B, C and D.





STARTING THE GAME

Tennis provides the player with two different game modes, Tournament and Free. When "Press Start Button" appears on the screen, the player may push the START button to bring up the Menu. Select with **↑** **↓** Directional buttons and confirm with the **⊗** button.



TOURNAMENT MODE

Player chases the champion with five round tournaments. When the player wins the Tournament in either **NORMAL** or **HARD** mode, a new character is added to the roster of players.

FREE MODE

Player selects from seven different modes in Singles and Double. Also, player may play VS mode and/or both players may play together.

Up to 4 players can compete at one time by using a Multitap.



TOURNAMENT MODE

Set Select



Select the numbers of sets.
Select from **1, 3, or 5.**

Character Select



There are a total of 16 different characters, each with their own unique skills, which allows for a wide variety of challenging matches. If a male character is selected, all opponents in the tournament will be male. If a female character is selected, all opponents will be female.

Game Level



Select from **EASY, NORMAL** or **HARD.**

Court Select



Select from **HARD, GRASS** or **CLAY.**
Hard: Pace is fast, and there is a strong bounce to the ball.
Grass: Pace is fast and there is a normal bounce to the ball.
Clay: Pace is slow and there is a normal bounce to the ball.

Toss/Serve

Pressing either the or buttons begins the match. Pressing either of these buttons causes the player to toss the ball into the air. As the ball falls back to the ground, the player presses either of these buttons again to initiate the first serve. Pressing a Directional button when serving will add extra movement to the ball.

Receive

The receiving player presses either the or buttons to accomplish a basic return.

Smash

If the ball is above the player's head, the player can smash it by pressing the button.

Volley

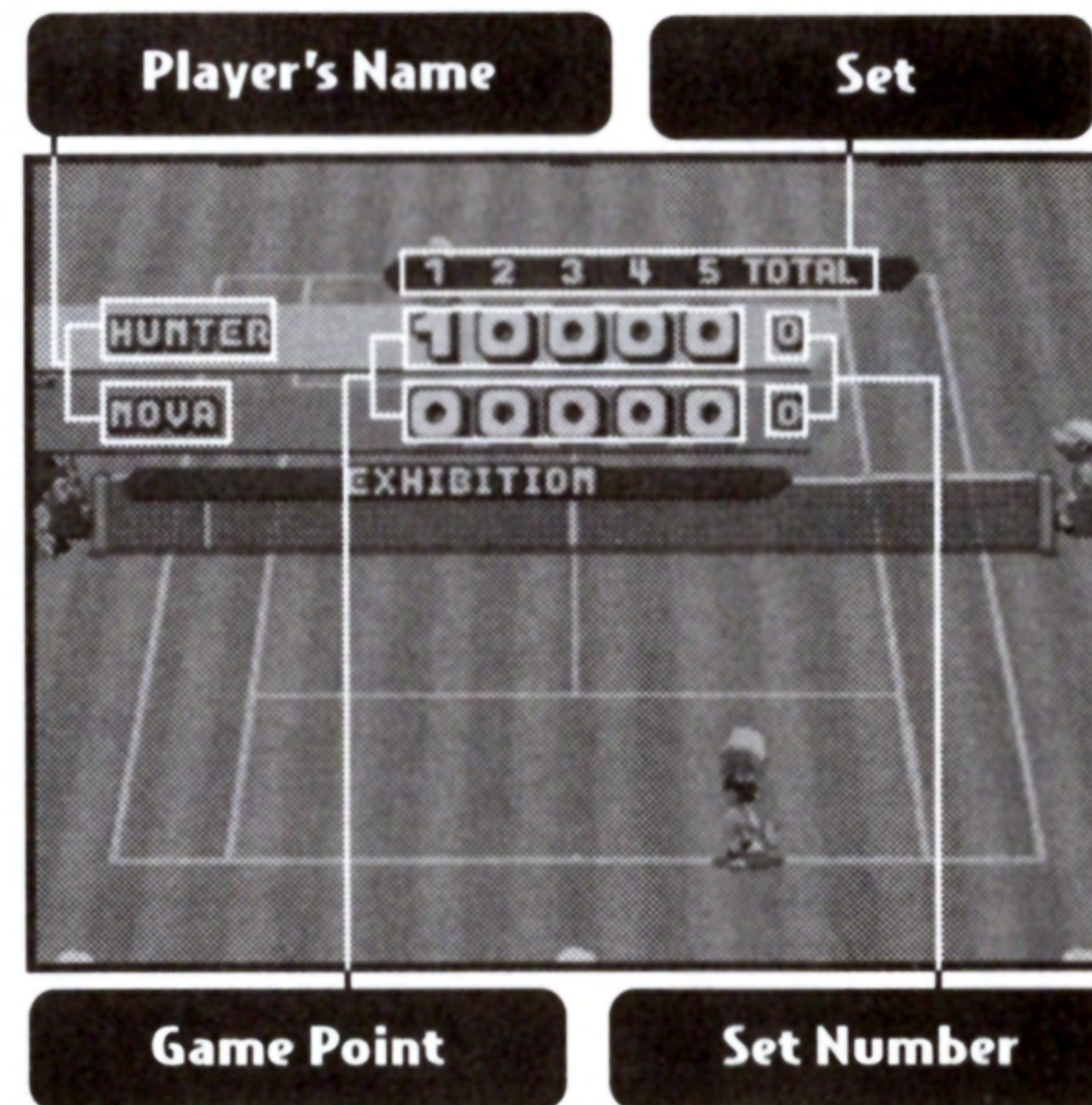
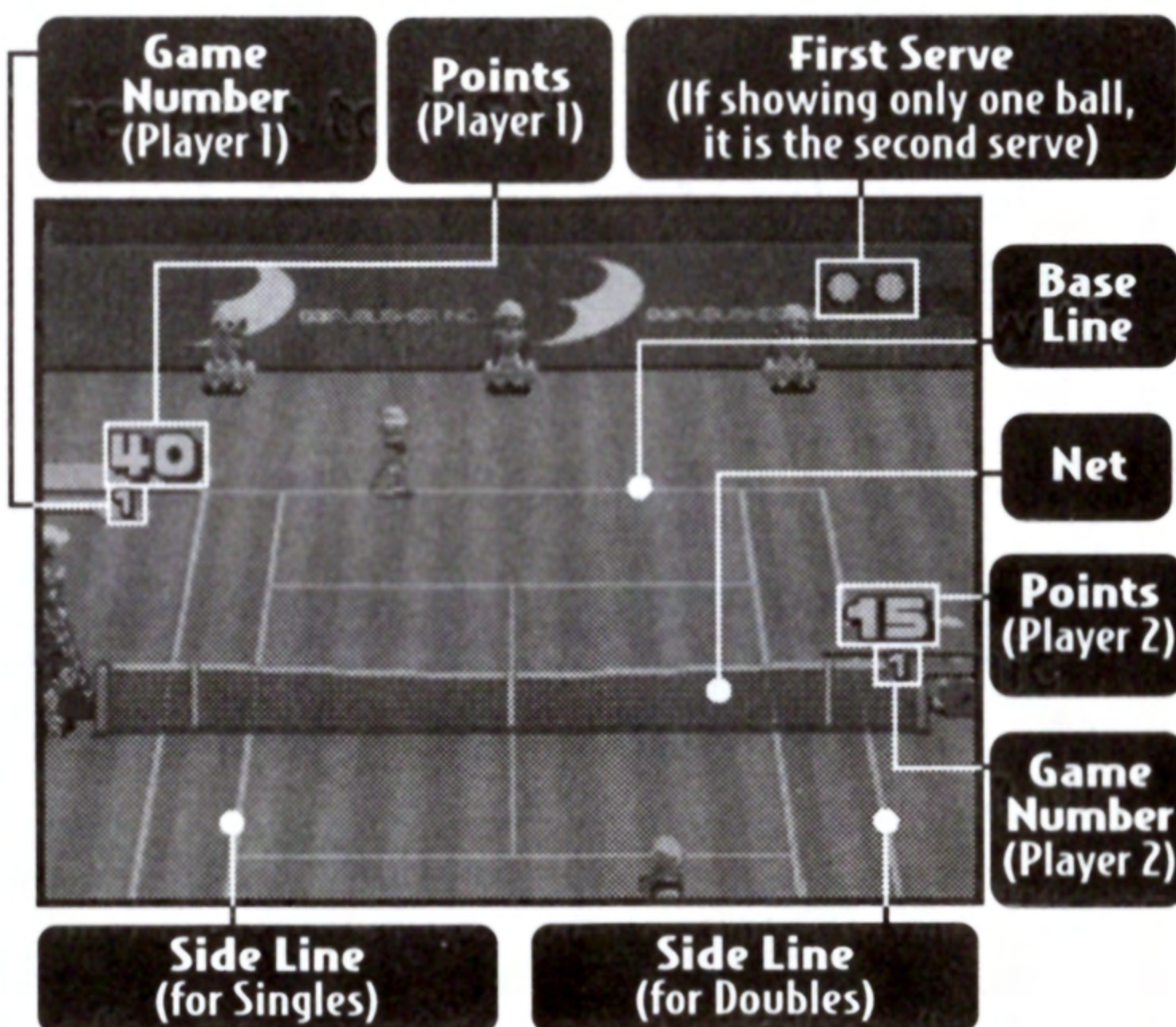
Play close to the net and press button to hit a volley.

Lob

When you are in the front court (the court on the bottom of the screen) and at the base line, press + buttons to deliver a lob shot. When you are in the back court (the court at the top of the screen) press + buttons to deliver a lob shot.

Drop Shot

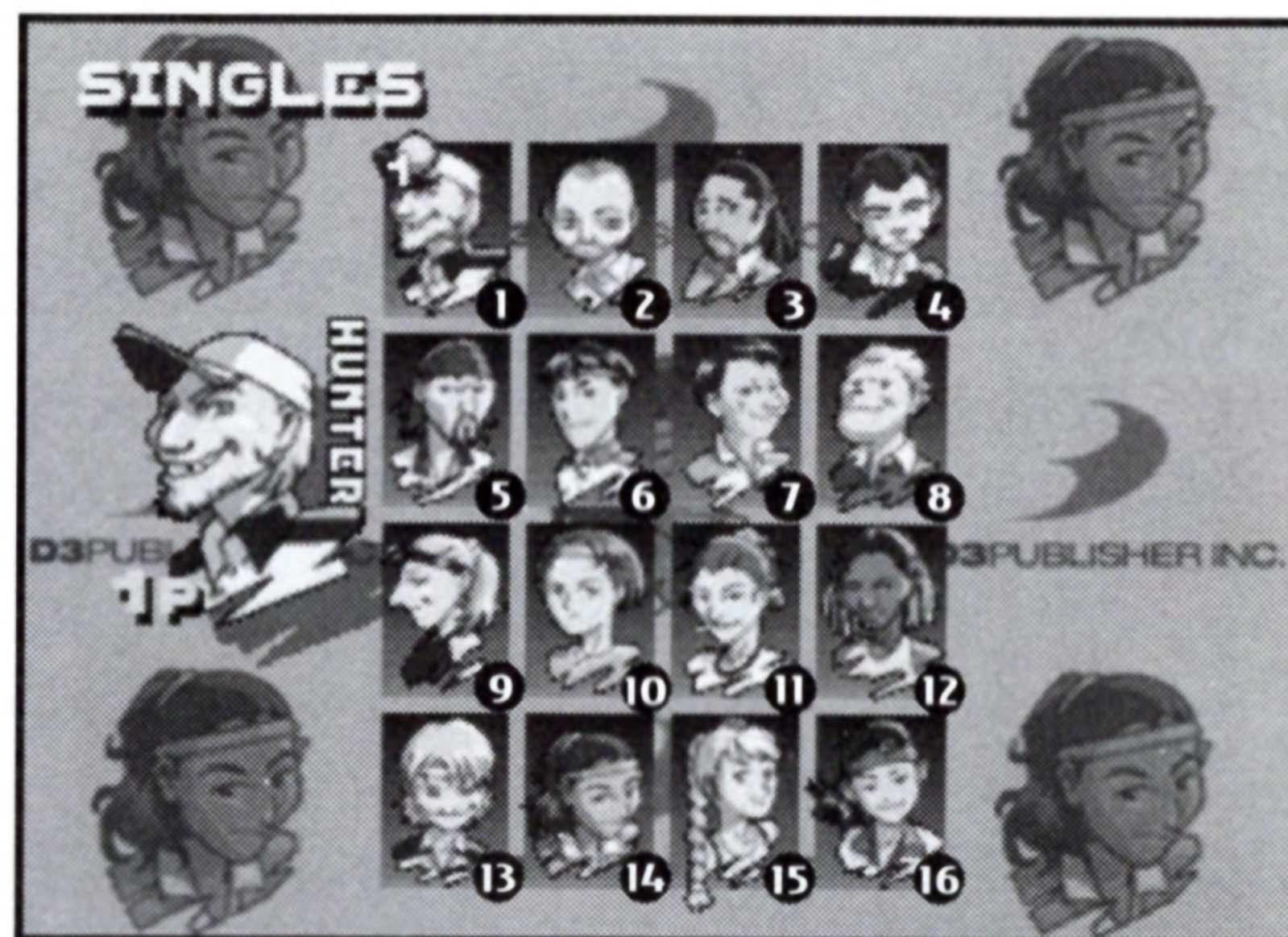
When you are in front court and at the edge of net press + buttons, when you are in the back court press + buttons.



Notes: Making the best shot is done creatively by using each character's ability while also cramping the other player's style. When the player performs an excellent shot, the ball glows yellow as it returns.

There are 16 characters to choose from for your players. Each character is listed below, complete with their unique abilities and personal traits (please see the chart). The 17th player is a bonus character that is awarded to you if you win the game in Tournament Mode. The 17th player is not in the Easy Mode.

1	HUNTER	Good at serving and volleying, quick reflexes.
2	ASSICA	Base-line player. Strong stroke shot, quick reflexes.
3	IVANOV	Left-handed player. Good at serving and volleying, quick reflexes.
4	UMETANI	Stable shot, good endurance.
5	LION	Base-line player. Strong stroke shot, quick reflexes.
6	SANPYON	All-around player. Strong serve and strong stroke shot.
7	CHARHANG	Stable stroke shot, good endurance.
8	TOM	Left-handed player. Base-line player. Strong stroke shot, quick reflexes.
9	PLUM	Base-line player. Strong stroke shot, quick reflexes.
10	DAISY	All-around player. Strong serve, strong stroke shot.

12	SACCHIN	Stable shot, good endurance.
13	SELENE	Left-handed player. Base-line player. Strong stroke shot, quick reflexes.
